Fall 2020 Hunting Permit Availability

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game is aware of the difficulties hunters may have getting permits for fall hunts due to state and local travel restrictions. Although most permits are available online, many hunts require hunters to pick up permits in-person in communities across the state. Some hunters are also accustomed to getting permits in communities in hunt areas, which may not be possible this fall due to travel restrictions. This issue is primarily centered around registration permits. Drawing permits were mailed directly to hunters in early July.

Hunters that are having difficulty obtaining registration permits are asked to contact Division of Wildlife Conservation regional offices (regions and phone numbers listed below) or local area offices to determine how best to receive desired permits.
