## **Nelchina Caribou Subsistence Hunts Season Closures**

(Glennallen) – The seasons for the Nelchina caribou subsistence hunts RC561, RC562, and CC001 will close at the end of the day on Friday, January 22, 2021. The majority of the Nelchina caribou herd is currently overwintering in Unit 13, which resulted in steady harvest among all winter hunts (DC485, CC001, RC561, and RC562) after the hunts opened on October 21<sup>st</sup>. The draw hunt DC485 closed on January 10<sup>th</sup> as overall harvest approached the winter harvestable surplus for the herd. Subsistence hunts remained open to fulfill the remaining quota, which will be met this week based on current harvest rates. Including federal harvest, a total of 1,421 caribou have been harvested to date in winter hunts in Unit 13.

Successful hunters can file hunt reports online at hunt.alaska.gov, by phone at (907) 822-3461 (24/7), or in person at the Glennallen or Palmer Fish and Game offices. Reporting is required within 3 days of kill for RC561 and RC562 permitholders. Reporting is required within 5 days of kill for CC001 permitholders. Unsuccessful hunters and those who did not hunt must report within 15 days of the season end.
