EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the State of Alaska resident and nonresident hunting season for mountain goat in registration permit hunt area RG230, which includes that portion of Unit 6C east of Sheridan Glacier and the main channel of Glacier River, and north of the Copper River Highway. Mountain goat hunting regulations in all other areas of Unit 6C are not affected by this emergency order.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in 5AAC 85.040 (2), **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Goat**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective:

All other mountain goat hunting regulations in Unit 6 are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

The most recent aerial surveys found 143 goats within the mountain goat hunt area RG230. The maximum allowable harvest is 7 goat points. Each billy counts as one goat point and each nanny counts as two goat points, and each unrecovered goat counts as 1.5 goat points. The current harvest is 7 billies and additional hunters are currently in the field. This closure is necessary to prevent exceeding harvest objectives.
