New Reporting Requirements for Goat Hunters in Unit 6D

Registration permits for mountain goat hunting in Game Management Unit 6D will be available August 25 online at hunt.alaska.gov, or at ADFG offices in person in Anchorage, Cordova, Fairbanks, Glennallen, Palmer, and Soldotna. Hunters should be aware that the reporting requirement for all Unit 6D goat hunts, except RG248, is now "within 3 days of kill." Successful hunters must report within three days in person or by phone (907-424-3215). Hunters may also call 907-424-3215 with preliminary reports that provide their name, hunt area, date of kill, and the sex of the goat. This information can also be provided by satellite communication such as an inReach device to Samantha.renner@alaska.gov.

Goat hunting in Unit 6D remains a very popular activity with consistent hunting opportunity for hunters. As technology improves, it has become easier to get good in-season hunt data. Better and more timely communication will help ensure future hunting opportunity.
