### EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state of Alaska resident and nonresident mountain goat hunting season for that portion of Unit 1(C) between Sawmill Creek and Gilkey River. This order takes effect at 11:59 pm, Saturday, October 11, 2014.

### REGULATORY TEXT:

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.040, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR GOAT, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting mountain goats in Unit 1(C):

Unit 1(C), that portion draining into Lynn Canal and Stephens Passage Between Sawmill Creek and Gilkey River	Oct. 1-Oct. 11 (General hunt only)	Oct. 1-Oct. 11
1 goat by registration permit only, the taking of nannies with kids is prohibited ....		
The remainder of Unit 1(C) mountain goat seasons, other than those previously closed by emergency order, are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

Based on aerial survey information collected in September 2014 a guideline harvest of 4 points (male goat=1 point & female goat=2 points) was established for the area. As of Thursday, October 9, 2014, the reported harvest is 2 female goats for a total of 4 points. Given that this area is relatively accessible by small boat and a portion of the Juneau road system, managers consider it necessary to close this season to prevent the additional harvest of female goats.
