PREREQUISITES:

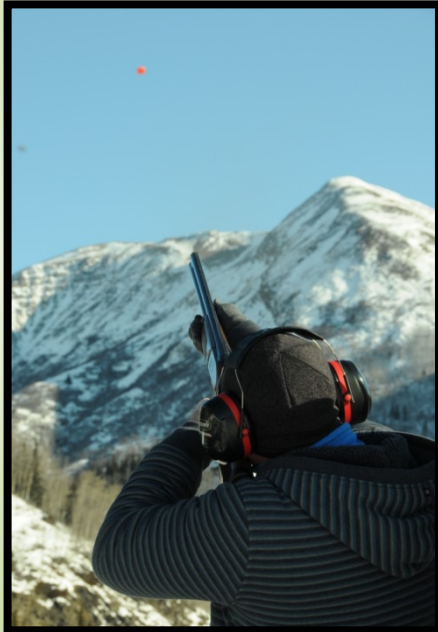
- *Hunter Education Certificate*
