

<u>Little Susitna Public Use Facility Boat Launch & Campground Rules</u>

- 1. The use of off road and all-terrain vehicles is prohibited (ATV, Dirt Bikes, Side by Sides and UTV).
- 2. All pets must be kept on a leash no longer than nine feet, and not left unattended. Facility users are responsible to clean up after their pet.
- 3. The use and discharge of FIREARMS & FIREWORKS is prohibited (including ARCHERY, BB, & PAINTBALL GUNS).
- 4. Ax and knife throwing is prohibited.
- 5. Falling and cutting of trees is prohibited.
- 6. Disturbing, damaging, or removing natural or cultural objects is prohibited; gathering berries, fruits, and mushrooms for personal consumption is permitted.
- 7. Littering is prohibited. Refuse may not be brought into the facility for disposal.
- 8. The discharge of sewage, wastewater or gray water is prohibited except at the facility dump station.
- 9. All unattended food and food containers must be secured in a hard-sided vehicle to prevent wildlife interactions.
- 10. Peddling, soliciting, vending of any goods or services is not permitted.
- 11. Ground fires are prohibited. All fires must be attended to and contained within the provided fire ring.
- 12. Camping stay limit is 14 nights. If the maximum stay limit is reached, all persons and property may not return to camp for 15 consecutive days.
- 13. Campsites must be physically occupied the first night paid. Vehicles and campsites left unattended for more than 48 hours may be impounded.
- 14. Two vehicles are allowed in each campsite, provided they fit without placing wheels off the gravel surface nor extended into the roadway. A vehicle is defined as a registered highway vehicle, towing vehicle, or trailer; tow vehicle + trailer = 2 vehicles.
- 15. Extra vehicles in a campsite will be required to pay daily parking fees. Extra vehicles using electricity in an RV site will be required to pay camping fees.
- 16. Check-in time is 1:00 pm or as campsites are made available. Check-out time is 12:00 (noon).
- 17. Campground quiet hours are from 11:00 pm to 6:00 am. This includes the use of generators. If all-night generator use is required for medical reasons, please check in with the camp host.
- 18. Camping is permitted only in designated sites and sleeping in vehicles constitutes camping.
- 19. All remote river access campsites are first-come, first-served.
- 20. No person may organize or conduct an assembly of more than 20 people in the public use facility unless authorized by a special area permit under 5 AAC 95.
- 21. DNR Alaska State Park Passes are NOT honored at this facility.

Camping activities within the LSPUF must be conducted in accordance with 5 AAC 95.515(4) and all posted campground rules.

Reservation Cancellations & No Shows will not be refunded.
