STUDY OBJECTIVES:

1. Develop, maintain and enhance Internet pages and web-based applications
2. Maintain and enhance Sport Fish Division's Intranet.

RESULTS/DISCUSSION:

Objective 1: Web page and associated applications accessible via the Department website provides the public access to a wide variety of educational materials and content about Alaska's fisheries resources, stocking updates, weir counts, harvest reporting and other sport fishing information. The site is continually updated and reviewed to ensure that accurate information is being offered.

Objective 2: The Sport Fish intranet is an authenticated (username and password required) web-based resource available to department personnel to provide access to internal resources and draft materials. It provides a secure environment to share resources during project development and for data entry and data analysis. Data entry, editing and lookup procedures are conducted through the intranet for the division's major projects, which include guide and business licensing, saltwater and freshwater logbook reporting, permit information (personal use salmon, shrimp, etc.), the statewide harvest survey and many others. Database interfaces continued to be maintained, updated and enhanced for the majority of the division's projects. An intricate and secure web based document management site is also used and maintained (DocuShare).
