STUDY OBJECTIVES: To provide accurate and timely reporting of Division of Sport Fish work funded by Federal Assistance and to make such reporting available to decision makers, project managers, and the public.

RESULTS/DISCUSSIONS: During this contract period, 49 reports were received for peer review and 49 peer reviews were completed, including 24 reports that received peer-review waivers (Sport Fish only: 13 received and 13 completed, including 2 that received peer review waivers). Additionally, 6 Fishery Data Series, 3 Fishery Manuscript, 4 Fishery Management Report, and 12 Special Publication reports for the Division of Sport Fish were published. These reports were distributed to state and local publication distribution centers, libraries and individuals and—upon request—to other libraries, agencies, and individuals.

A searchable bibliography of reports was maintained, and electronic files were converted to Adobe Portable Document Format for distribution to agency archives and libraries. The reports were made available online through an interactive search database:

Reports posted online were formatted with linked tables of contents, internal bookmarks, and optical character recognition to allow for full-text searching.
