STUDY OBJECTIVES:

1. Collect 800,000 Chinook salmon eggs from the returning stock at Deception Creek.

RESULTS/DISCUSSIONS:

Objectives 1: Objective 1 was very close to being met. A total of 606,344 fertilized Chinook salmon eggs were taken from Deception Creek, the goal of 800,000 was missed due to low returns of Chinook adults. In order to meet stocking goals for Deception Creek an additional 126,675 eggs were used from Ship Creek to complete the Eklutna Tailrace stocking events.

This performance report is the final report for project S-2-26 for the grant period.
