Bowhead Whale Feeding in the Alaskan Beaufort Sea

We studied feeding of bowhead whales taken by Alaska Natives at Barrow (western Beaufort Sea) and Kaktovik (eastern Beaufort Sea). Our objectives were to: 1) identify the proportion of harvested whales that had been feeding (data from 1969-2000); and 2) describe diet based on stomach contents (88 whales harvested during 1986-2000). There was no significant difference in the proportion of animals that had been feeding during the fall at Kaktovik (75%) and Barrow (73%) ($X^2 = 0.69$; df = 1; P > 0.1). Copepods occurred more frequently in animals from Kaktovik ($X^2 = 43.04$; df = 1; P < 0.001), while euphausiids ($X^2 = 10.61$; df = 1, P < 0.001) and hyperiid amphipods ($X^2 = 12.39$; df = 1; P < 0.001) occurred more frequently at Barrow. During the fall, the percent copepods by volume was greater in animals taken at Kaktovik than at Barrow (mean = 60.7% vs 4.5%; t = 5.45; df = 23; P < 0.001), while the percent euphausiids by volume was greater in whales from Barrow than from Kaktovik (mean = 84.2% vs 21.9%; t = 6.88; df = 29; P < 0.001). At Barrow, a larger proportion of animals was feeding in the fall (73%) than the spring (31%) $(X^2 = 35.77; df = 1; P < 0.001)$, and copepods occurred more often in the spring ($X^2 = 31.52$; df = 1; P < 0.001). Bowhead whales feed regularly in both the eastern and western Alaskan Beaufort Sea, and there are regional and seasonal differences in their diet.
