
Caribou Hunters

RC860 Fortymile Caribou No-Hunt Corridor



Taylor Highway/Top of the World Highway (Boundary Cutoff) No-Hunt Corridor:

That portion of Unit 20E within a corridor extending 100 feet from each side of the road, including the drivable surface of the road, between mileposts 75.3 and 117.2 of the Taylor Highway, and along the entire length of the Top of the World Highway (Boundary Cutoff). This area is closed to the taking of caribou during the fall RC860 state Fortymile caribou season. This corridor applies to caribou hunting only and will be in effect during the state portion of the season.
