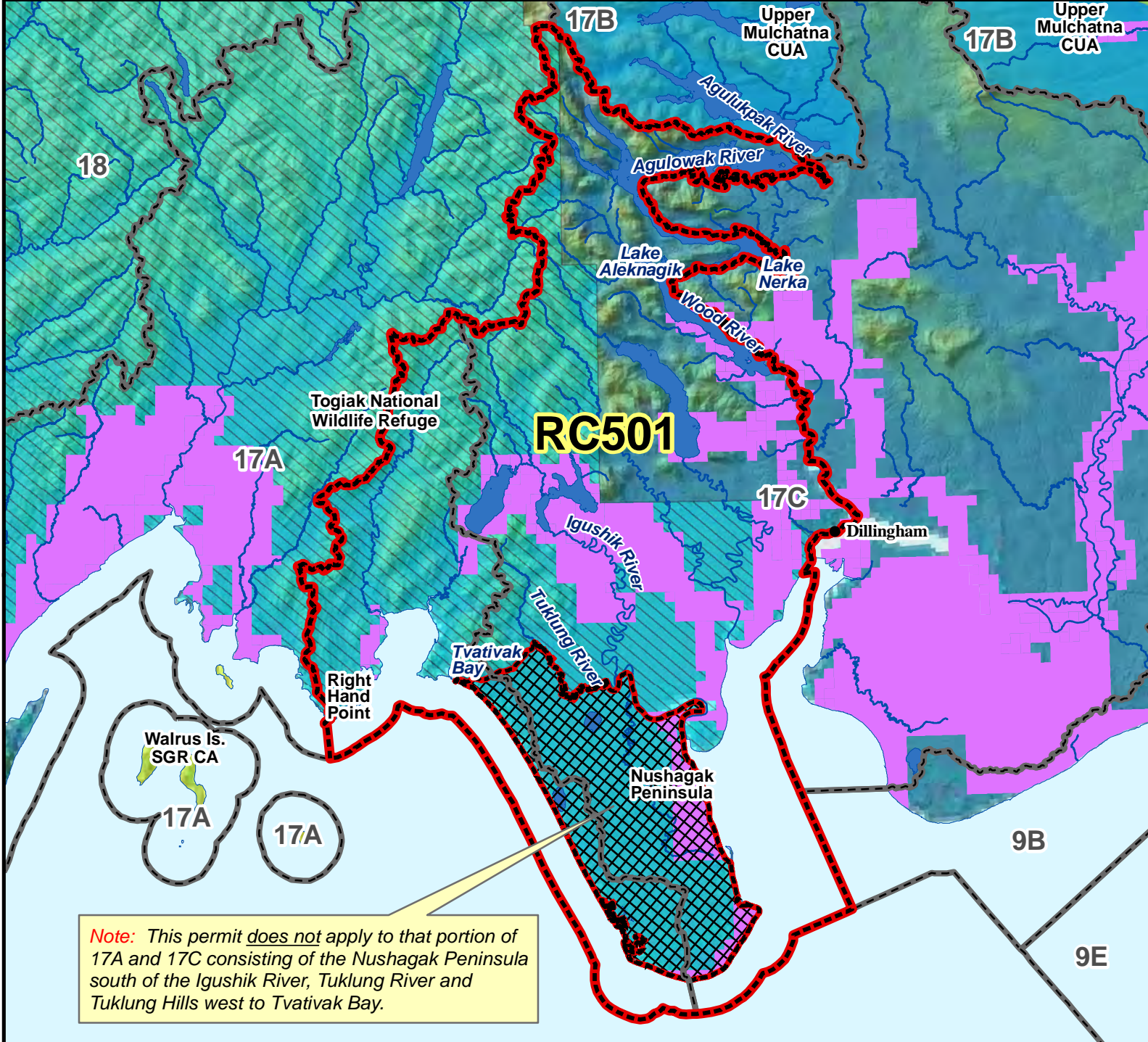


# RC501 Caribou Registration Permit Hunt

This map is intended for hunt planning use, not for determining legal property or regulatory boundaries. Content is compiled from various sources and is subject to change without notice. See current hunting regulations for written descriptions of boundaries. Hunters are responsible for knowing the land ownership and regulations of the areas they intend to hunt.



**Note:** This permit does not apply to that portion of 17A and 17C consisting of the Nushagak Peninsula south of the Igushik River, Tuklung River and Tuklung Hills west to Tvativak Bay.

**AREA DESCRIPTION:** Units 17A, all drainages that terminate east of Right Hand Point; and 17C, remainder.

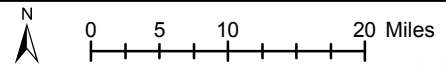
**Open areas under the RC501 permit include:**

- 17A, all drainages that terminate east of Right Hand Point, except that area consisting of the Nushagak Peninsula south of the Igushik River, Tuklung River and Tuklung Hills west to Tvativak Bay
- 17C, west of the east banks of the Wood River, Lake Aleknagik, Agulowak River, Lake Nerka, and the Agulupak River (noted as 17C remainder in the Alaska Hunting Regulations), except that area consisting of the Nushagak Peninsula south of the Igushik River, Tuklung River and Tuklung Hills west to Tvativak Bay.

**Land status is derived from ADNR, General Land Status, Oct. 2015.**

**It is generalized and accurate only to the section level.**
