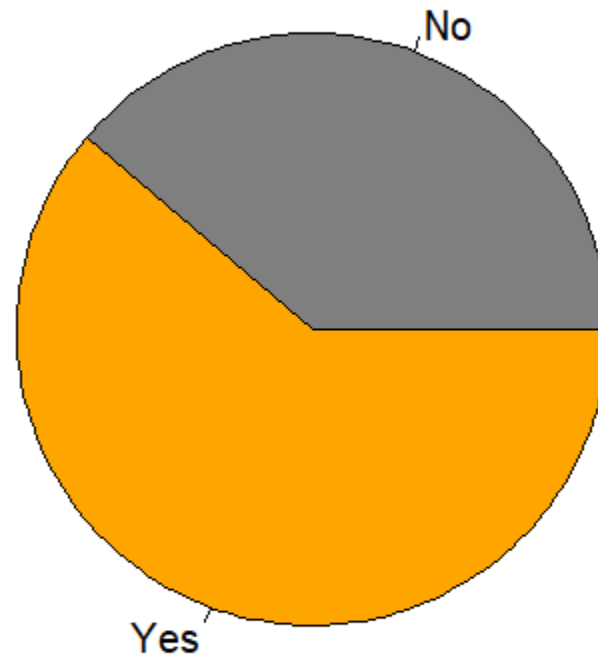
During the summer of 2019, ADF&G Waterfowl Program staff conducted an online survey of individuals who purchased an Alaska duck stamp in 2018 to collect information on 4 species of conservation concern: Brant, Sandhill Cranes, Common Eiders, and King Eiders. The survey link was sent to 1,000 randomly selected duck stamp purchasers in late August 2019. The survey closed on 15 October 2019, with responses from 317 individuals. The following pages present a brief summary of the survey results.

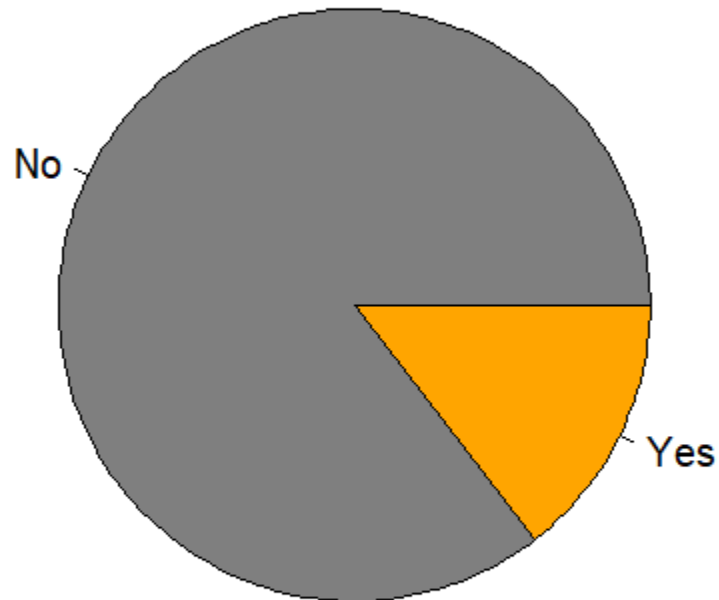

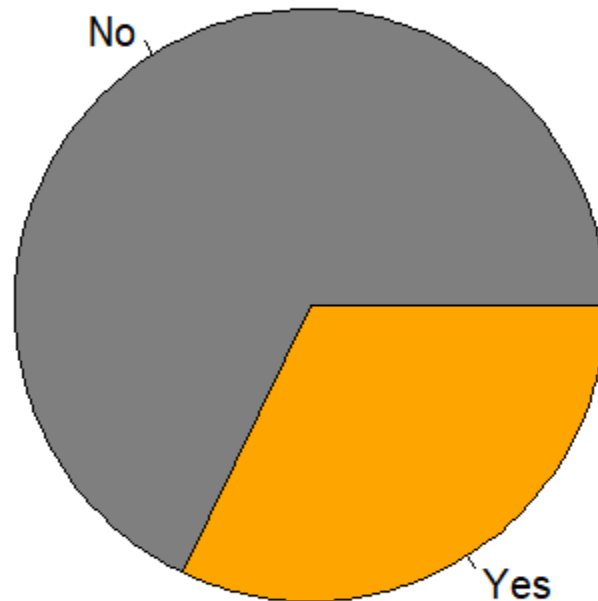

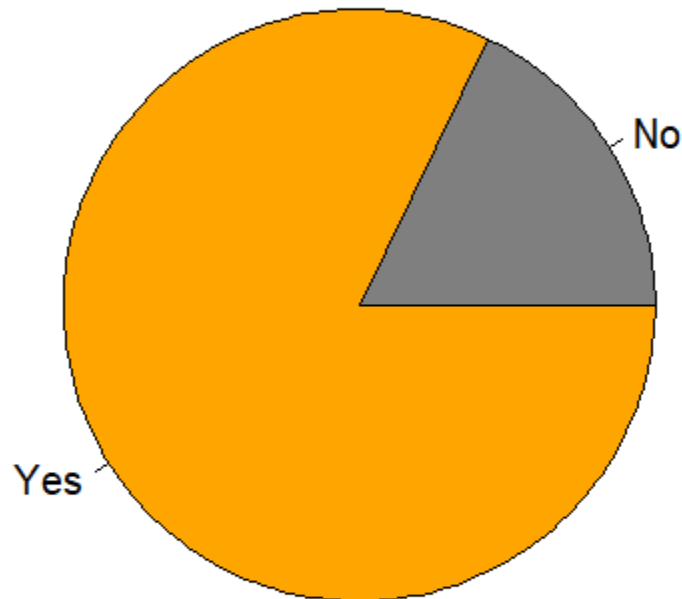

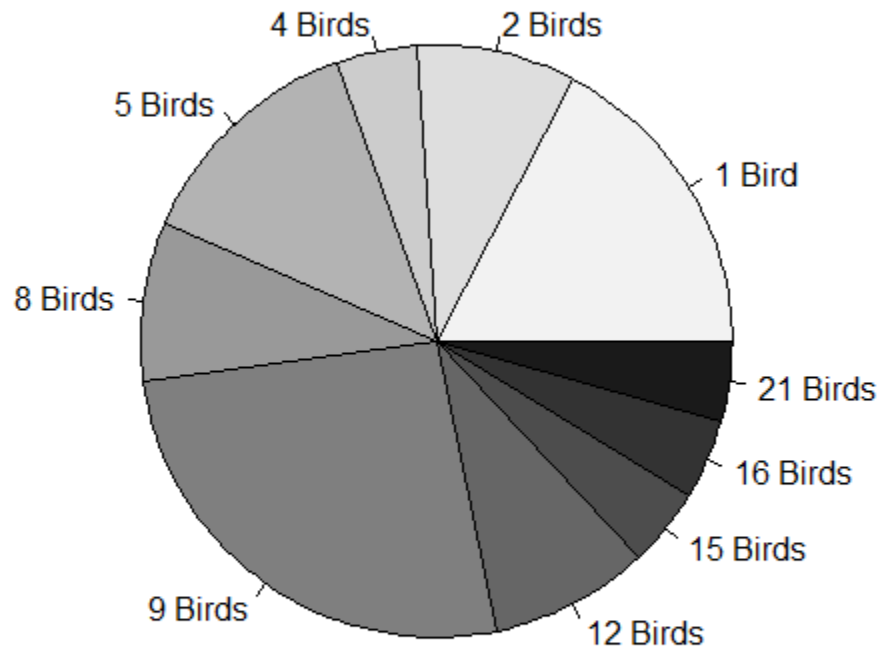

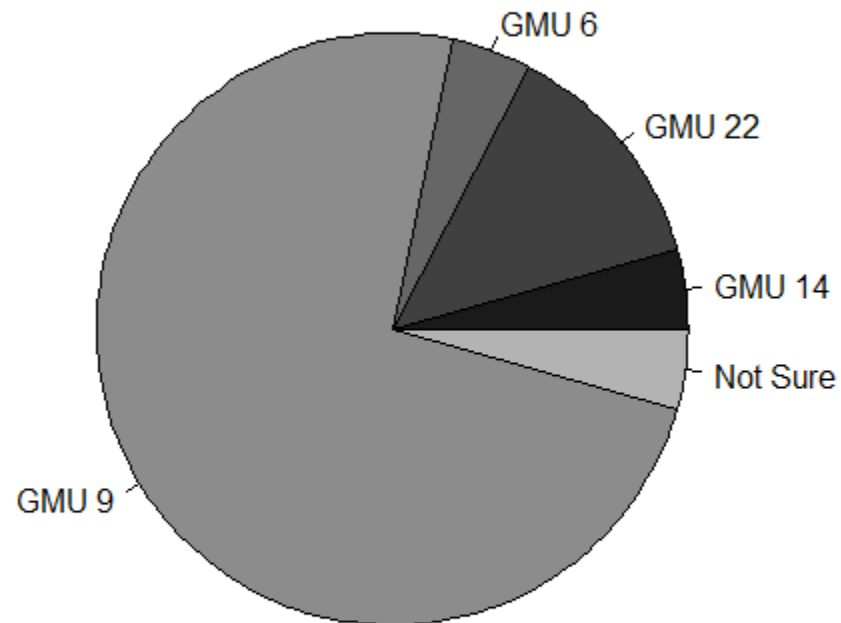

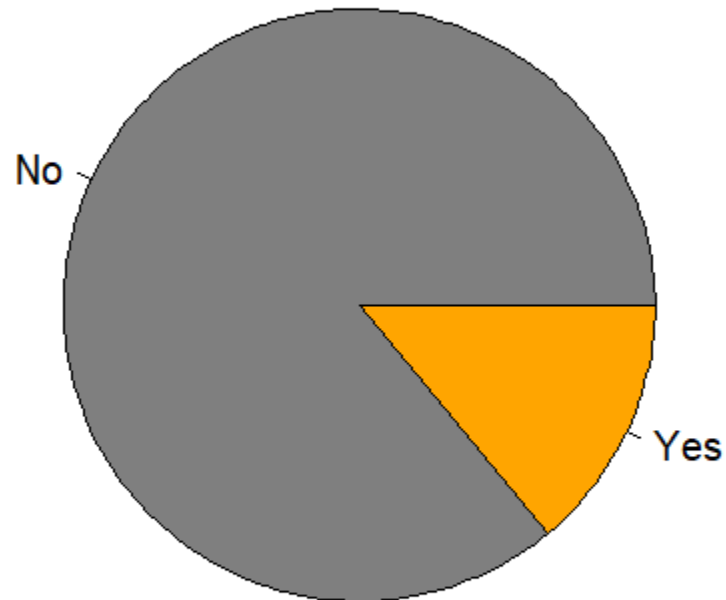

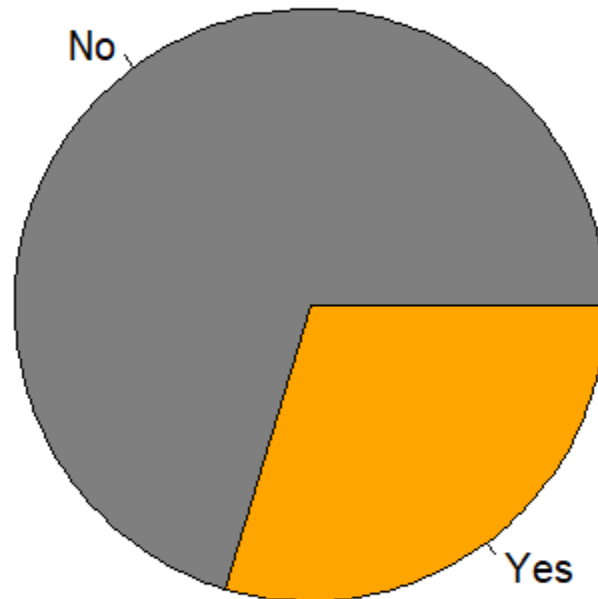

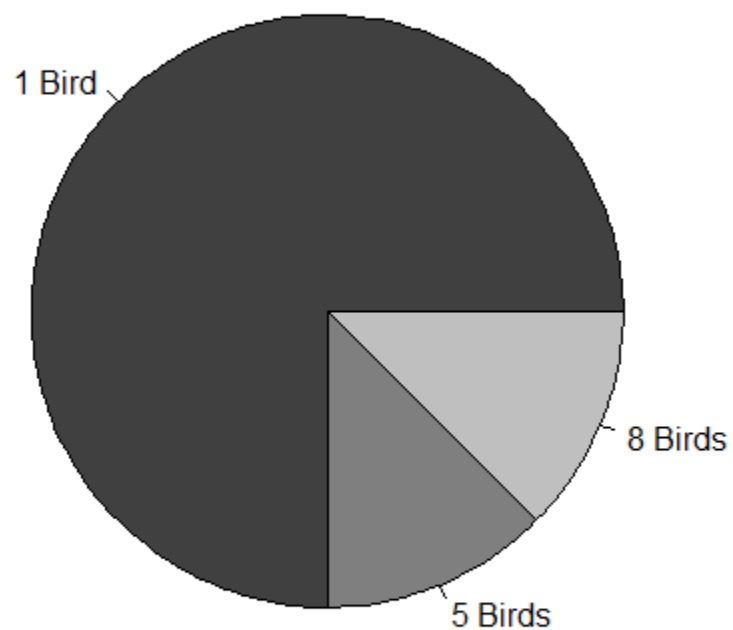

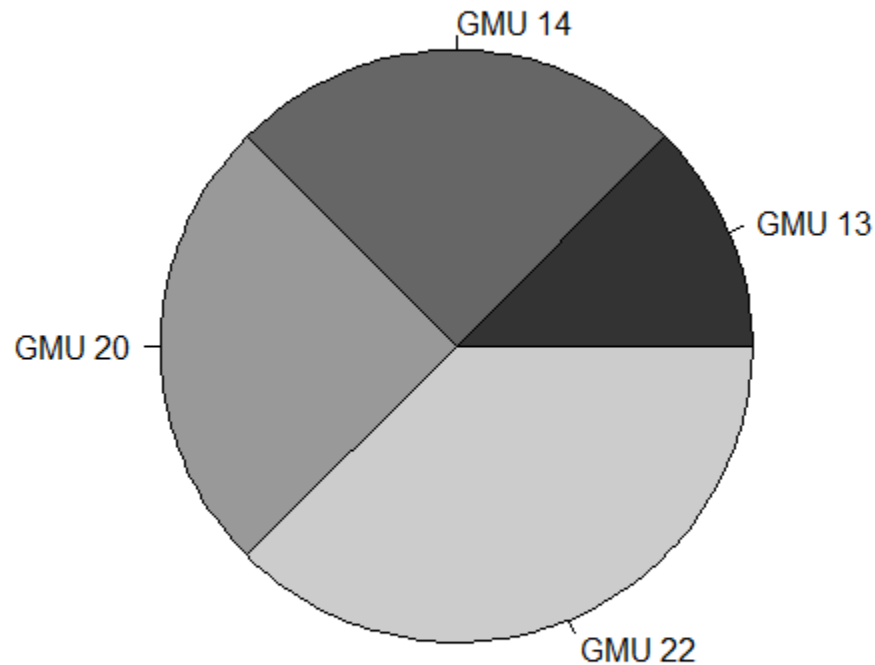

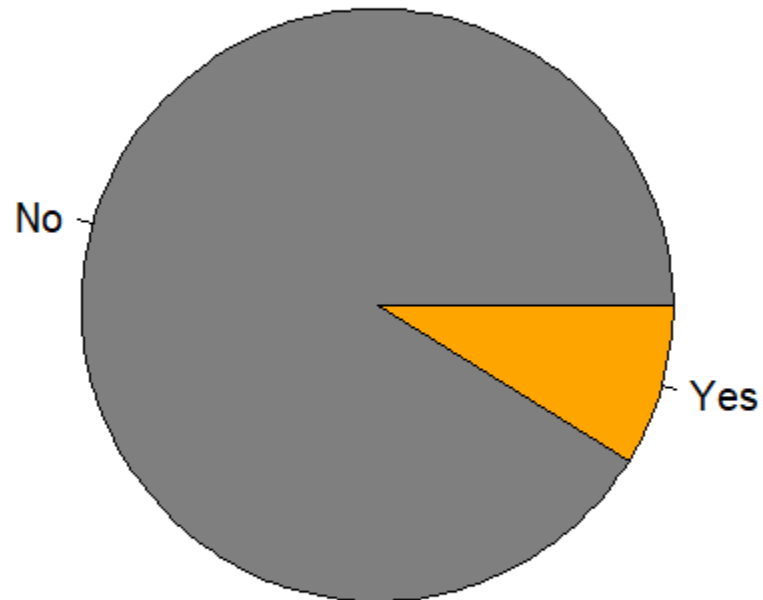

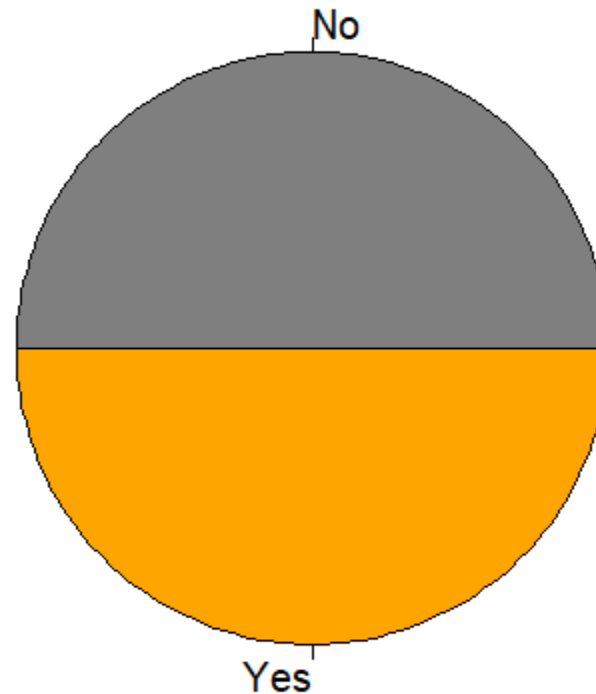

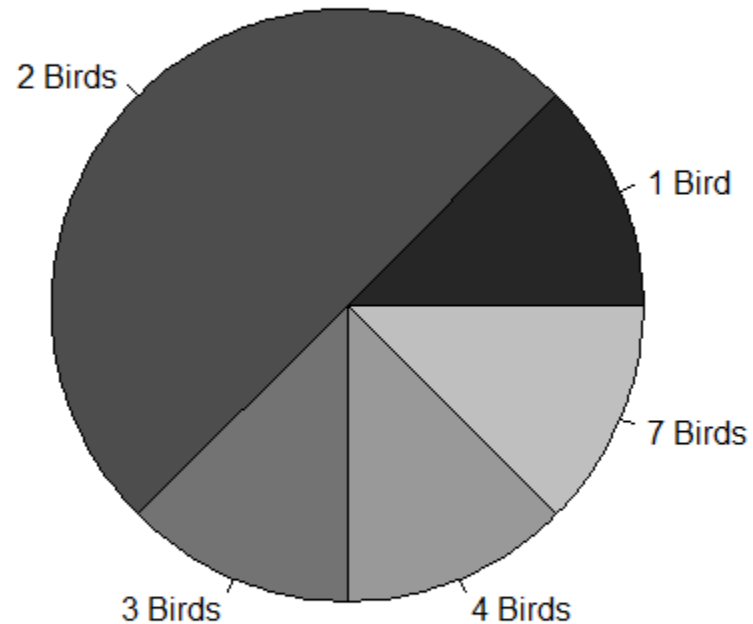

Number of Respondents = 17

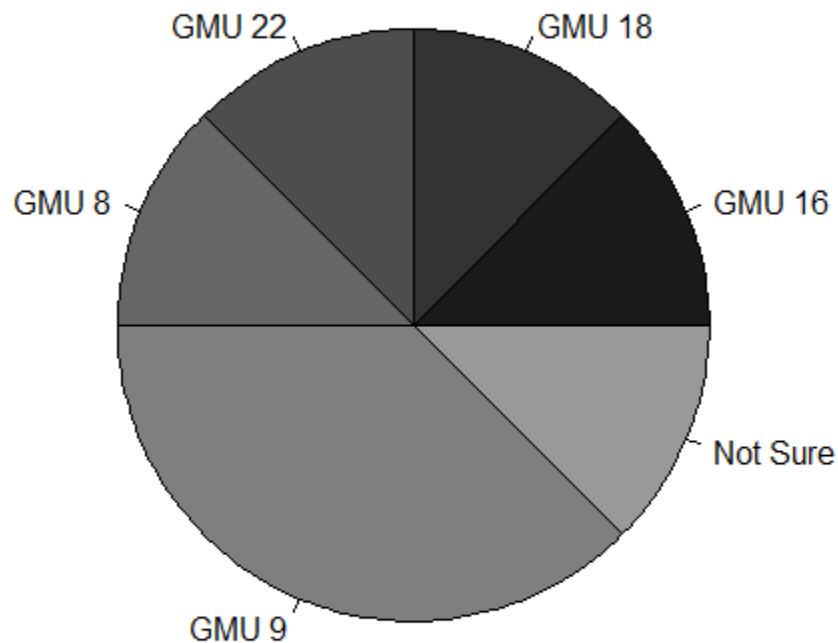

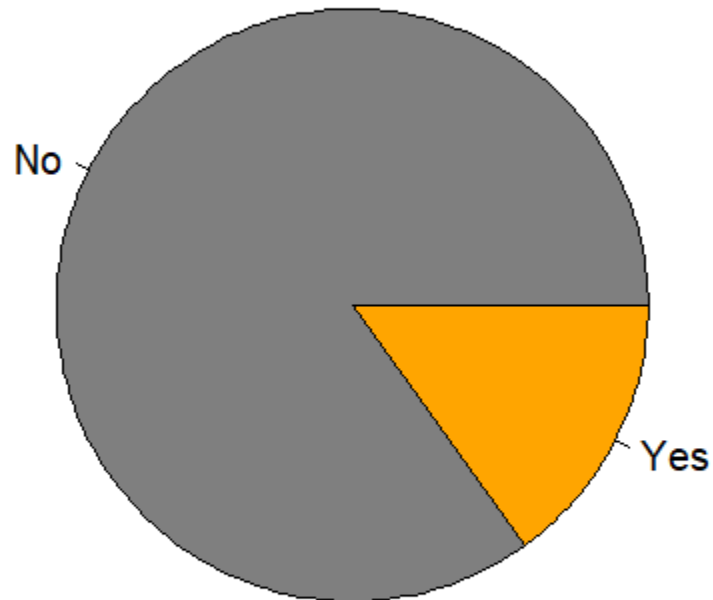

Number of Respondents = 192

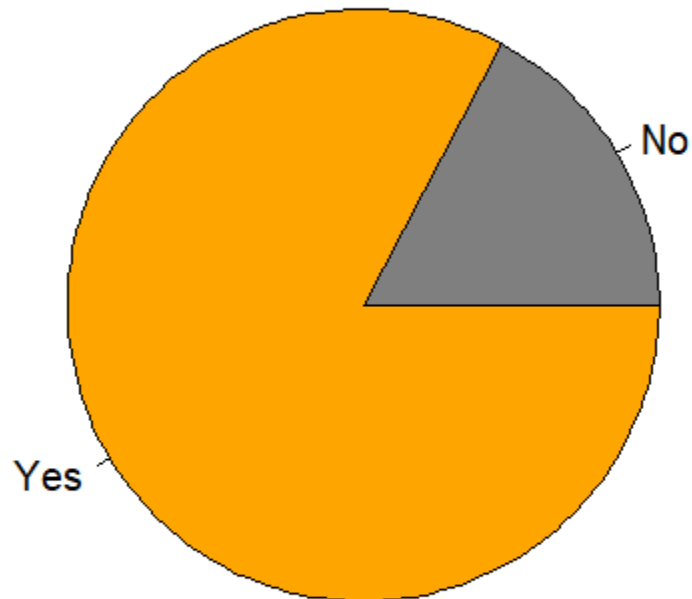

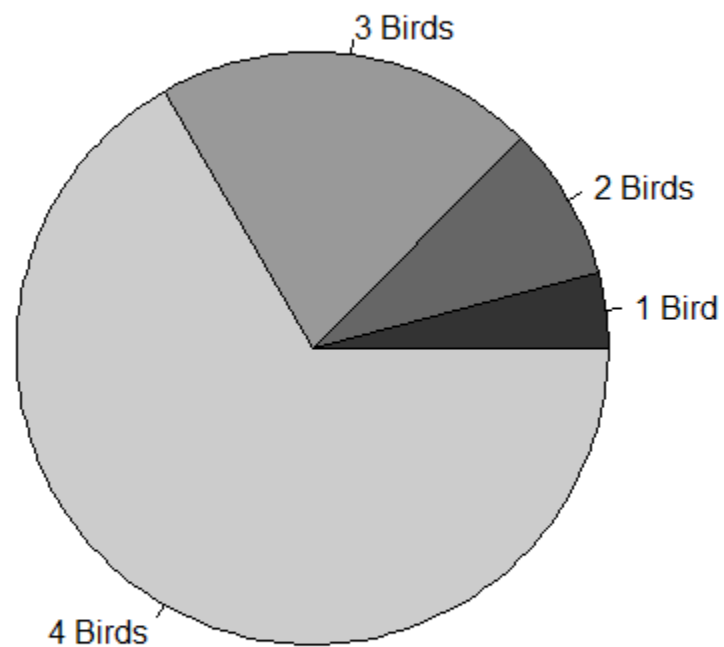
