ADF&G Independent Buyer Permit Application

Intent to Operate

This is an application for an Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) Independent Buyer Permit. As an independent buyer you are permitted to write ADF&G fish tickets for unprocessed fishery resource you buy from fisherman. You can only sell the unprocessed resource in Alaska to licensed processors or exporters. If the processor or exporter you sell to does not have a Fishery Business License from the Alaska Department of Revenue (DOR), they must have a Processing Waiver from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation. Each fisherman you buy from must have a valid commercial fishing or landing permit issued by the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission. As a first buyer of unprocessed fish from fisherman, you must meet bonding requirements per DOR at (907) 465-2320. If you process or export the resource, you must obtain a Fisheries Business License from DOR. A person may operate as an independent buyer only after receiving an authorization letter, a code plate, and fish tickets from ADF&G. No fee is required for this permit.
