- \_\_\_ **62** Allow live salmon to be held in a cooperative fish pen by commissioner's permit.
- \_\_\_ **63** Allow cooperative fishermen to record multiple deliveries on a single fish ticket.
- \_\_\_ **64** Repeal the provision for an annual Chignik Alaska Board of Fisheries meeting.

**Pacific Cod-Adak Area**

- \_\_\_ **453** Consider allowing trawl gear for vessels 60 feet and under in the P. cod fishery.
