Substitute regulatory language for Proposal 187

5 AAC 09.366(d) is amended to read:

5 AAC 09.366. Post-June Salmon Management Plan for the South Alaska Peninsula.

(d) Notwithstanding (c)(1) of this section, from July 6 through July 31, the commissioner may establish, by emergency order, six 36-hour fishing periods, followed by a closure of at least 60 hours, except that the first fishing period on July 6 will begin at 6:00 a.m. and not exceed 33 hours [SIX 24-HOUR FISHING PERIODS INTERSPERSED BY 48 HOUR CLOSURES FROM JULY 6 THROUGH JULY 21, AND THREE 36-HOUR FISHING PERIODS INTERSPERSED BY 48 HOUR CLOSURES FROM JULY 22 THROUGH JULY 31. THE FIRST COMMERCIAL FISHING PERIOD OF THE JULY 22 THROUGH JULY 31 PERIOD MAY NOT START BEFORE 12:00 NOON ON JULY 23].
