Below are the statistics taken from Bob Clarke's ADF&G report presented to the Board of Fish on Friday, January 31, 2014:

- 1. The Little Su produces large returns from small escapements of coho;
- 2. High flows in 2012 probably underestimated coho escapements;
- 3. Coho are different than kings, small escapements can produce very large returns;
- 4. Coho escapements are difficult to enumerate due to vast distributions throughout watersheds;
- 5. The number of smolts that go to the ocean are the determining factor of returns;
- 6. Smolt-out migration is the best indicator of adult returns;
- 7. Coho stocks recover more quickly due to smolt survivability and the number of smolt-out migration;
- 8. Coho can have a 15-20% marine survival. Coho can have a 15-20% marine survival.
