
Chignik Salmon Management Plan (1999; 5 AAC 15.357)

- In effect from June 1 through October 31
- Fishing periods established by emergency order (EO)
- Purse seine and hand purse seine gear
- Organized into districts or groups of districts
 - Eastern District
 - Chignik Bay and Central districts
 - Western and Perryville districts





Inriver Run Goal (IRRG)


- 50,000 sockeye salmon in addition to late run escapement objectives to provide for late season subsistence needs

- 25,000 of the IRRG sockeye salmon September 1–15






















Chignik Management Area Peak Chum Salmon Escapement







Chignik Management Area Sockeye Salmon Harvest


