July 6-25 IF 300 thousand has been reached and a total 600,000 Chignik catch is still expected,

1st fishing period: At 6 a.m. open 25 hrs. then closes for 71 hrs.;

Following the 71hr. Closure, fishing will begin at 6 a.m. for 27hrs. then close for 69hrs. -w/schedule repeating

thru July 25.

Chignik Forecast for 1st and 2nd runs

Expected to provide less than 600,000 harvest in Chignik

Beginning June 7--- No Fishery until 300,000 harvested in Chignik

IF 300,000 has been harvested---

fishery opens 6 a.m. for 66 hrs. then is closed for 54 hrs. w/schedule repeating thru midnight June 27.

June 27- thru July 5th Closed for Chignik 2nd run evaluation

July 6- 25 If at least a 300,000 Chignik harvest has occurred and escapement goals are being met and a total 600,000 Chignik harvest

is not expected by July 25, no fishing shall occur until at least a total of 600,000 Chignik harvest is expected.

If at least a Chignik harvest of 600,000 is expected, the 1st fishing period will begin at 6 a.m. for 25hrs. then close for 71hrs. Following the 71hr. closure, fishing will begin at 6 a.m. for 27hrs. then close for 69hrs. -w/schedule repeating thru July 25.
