Beginning June 7	At 6 a.m. open 44 hrs. then 64 hrs. closed-w/schedule repeating to midnight June 27th
June 27- thru July 5	Closed for Chignik 2nd run evaluation
<u>July 6- 25</u>	IF 300 thousand has been reached and a total 600,000 Chignik catch is still expected, <u>1st fishing period</u> : At 6 a.m. open 24 hrs. then closes for 133 hrs. ; Following the 133hr. Closure, fishing will begin at 6 a.m. for 24hrs. then close for 120hrsw/schedule repeating thru July 25.

### Expected to provide less than 600,000 harvest in Chignik

 Beginning June 7-- No Fishery until 300,000 harvested in Chignik

 IF 300,000 has been harvested-- fishery opens 6 a.m. for 44 hrs. then is closed for 64 hrs. w/schedule repeating thru midnight June 27.

June 27- thru July 5th Closed for Chignik 2nd run evaluation

July 6- 25If at least a 300,000 Chignik harvest has occurred and escapement goals are being met and a total 600,000 Chignik harvest<br/>is not expected by July 25, no fishing shall occur until at least a total of 600,000 Chignik harvest is expected.<br/>If at least a Chignik harvest of 600,000 is expected, the 1st fishing period will begin at 6 a.m. for 24hrs. then close for 86hrs.<br/>Following the 133hr. closure, fishing will begin at 6 a.m. for 24hrs. then close for 120hrs. -w/schedule repeating thru July 25.
