Per our conversation: If the Board of Fish decides to extend the allowed seaward distance from 500 feet to 750 feet, shore fishery lease holders would need to apply for a lease amendment if they wanted to move their lease tracts further seaward. When a lease changes location or increases in size an amendment application is required.
