Proposed substitute language for Proposal 4

5 AAC 28.360 (b) is amended to read:

(b) An operator of a vessel participating in the Cook Inlet sablefish fishery shall obtain [AND COMPLETE A] sablefish [LOGBOOK] **log sheets** provided by the department. The vessel operator must have the [LOGBOOK] **log sheets** on board the vessel at all times and must submit to the department [EACH LOGBOOK] **a completed log sheet** page [THAT CORRESPONDS] with each ADF&G sablefish fish ticket.

(1) A log sheet described in (b) of this section must:

(A) include the date, the specific location of harvest by latitude and longitude, the number of hooks fished and number of skates, or the number of pots fished, the average depth of each set fished, and the time gear is deployed and hauled of each set;

(B) include for the target species, and for each bycatch species, the number of fish retained and discarded;

(C) be updated not later than 11:59 p.m. local time on the day after the day of operation; and

(D) be made available to a local representative of the department upon request.

(2) A person may not make a false entry in the log sheets described in (b) of this section.

Proposed substitute language for Proposal 5

5 AAC 28.365(e) is amended to read:

(e) An operator of a vessel participating in the Cook Inlet directed rockfish fishery shall obtain [AND COMPLETE A] rockfish [LOGBOOK] **log sheets** provided by the department. The vessel operator must have the [LOGBOOK] **log sheets** on board the vessel at all times [THE VESSEL IS PARTICIPATING IN THE COOK INLET DIRECTED ROCKFISH FISHERY.] **and must submit to the department a completed log sheet page with each ADF&G directed rockfish fish ticket.**

(1) A log sheet described in (e) of this section must:

(A) include the date, the specific location of harvest by latitude and longitude, the number of hooks fished and number of skates, the average depth of each set fished, and the time gear is deployed and hauled of each set;

(B) include for the target species, and for each bycatch species, the number of fish retained and discarded;

(C) be updated not later than 11:59 p.m. local time on the day after the day of operation; and

(D) be made available to a local representative of the department upon request.

(2) A person may not make a false entry in the log sheets described in (e) of this section.
