

Proposal 39 – Equal allocation between cost recovery and common property RC 033

- 97% + of the Resurrection Bay Harvest is Hatchery Produced as evidenced by Otolith Analysis (RC28)

- Inability to maximize cost recovery could lead to loss of entire run in addition to Silver stocking which is used for Seward Silver Derby

- There is currently a common property component in the sport fishery (RC25)

- Other Aquaculture Associations use one hatchery for large portions of cost recovery (DIPAC, NSRAA)

- Cook Inlet Aquaculture Association funds programs for Invasive Species Eradication (Pike, Elodea etc.), Beaver Dam notching, flow control structure operations and youth education, among others
