RC Substitute language for proposal 249

5 ACC 35.525 (c)

(3) in the South Peninsula District, if the

- (A) guideline harvest level is 1,000,000-2,000,000 pounds, an aggregate of no more than 20 pots may be operated from a validly registered Tanner crab vessel;
- (B) guideline harvest level is 2,000,000 -3,000,000 pounds, an aggregate of no more than 30 pots may be operated from a validly registered Tanner crab vessel;
- (C) guideline harvest level is more than 3,000,000 pounds, an aggregate of no more than 50 pots may be operated from a validly registered Tanner crab vessel;
- (D) the department will establish the individual vessel pot limit, not to exceed 50 pots per vessel, by dividing the 1,000 total pot limit by the number of vessels that register by the registration deadline specified in 5 AAC 35.506(e)(7);

5 ACC 35.506(e)(7) for the South Peninsula District *C. bairdi* Tanner crab fishery, the registration deadline is 5PM, December 24.
