Mt. Yenlo Fish and Game Advisory Committee Emergency Petition

At its April 24, 2018 meeting the board found the Mt. Yenlo Fish and Game Advisory Committee’s petition was an emergency by a vote of 4-2. The board did not finalize work beyond the finding. The board met on May 14, 2018 to act on the finding.

BOF meeting 05-14-18 - 9:24:51 AM

By a vote of 5-1 the board agreed to add king salmon to the Upper Yentna Subsistence Salmon Fishery. Subsequently, the board passed amendments to 5 AAC 01.566, 5 AAC 01.593, and 5 AAC 01.595 unanimously. The board also delegated to the department a request to make the regulations permanent.

Tyonek Fish and Game Advisory Committee Emergency Petition

The Tyonek Fish and Game Advisory Committee submitted an April 23, 2108 emergency petition to allow commercial harvest of king salmon in the Upper Cook Inlet Northern District set net fishery. The board did not find an emergency for this petition by a vote of 0-6.

The Kenai River Sport Fishing Association submitted an emergency petition on May 1, 2018, asking the department to stay its decision to allow the Valdez Fisheries Development Association, a Valdez-based salmon hatchery, to increase its production of pink salmon brood stock. The board did not find an emergency by a vote of 3-3.
