5 AAC 01.610(g) is amended to read:

(g) Salmon may be taken in the districts described in 5 AAC 01.605(b), at any time [ONLY] from May 1 [15] through October 31, except [DURING FISHING PERIODS AS FOLLOWS] in those districts open to commercial salmon fishing, a commercial salmon permit holder and associated commercial salmon vessel may not subsistence fish for salmon during the 24 hours before a commercial salmon fishing period in which they participate. Subsistence salmon harvested before the first commercial salmon fishing period must be reported within 24 hours of leaving the fishing grounds. [FROM MAY 15 UNTIL TWO DAYS BEFORE THE COMMERCIAL OPENING OF THAT SALMON DISTRICT, SEVEN DAYS PER WEEK;]

- (1) [during the commercial salmon season, only during open commercial salmon fishing periods in that district;]
- (2) [from two days following the closure of the commercial salmon fishing season in that district through October 31, seven days a week.]
