The first Department of Natural Resource (DNR) leases were issued in 1964. The State of Alaska DNR cites the reason for creation of the program was to reduce and resolve user conflict. The DNR does this by limiting permit holders to operate up to three nets. Shown in the photo below are the current registered sites. There are only 62 leased and registered sites with DNR, with a potential of 87.
