Lee House Testimony I'm here this morning to talk to you a little bit about historic Sitka Sound Herring Robi Craig Levels On the subject of the herring, it is safe to say that we have been concerned about the stocks for quite some time, not just now Ray Nielsen Jr When I was a youngster, from Jamestown Bay all the way down to Goddard Hot Springs Archie Nielsen Eggs spawned all over the Sitka Sound area, all of this area was white when the herring came in Isabella Brady Herring was plentiful then Herman Kitka And everybody had their favorite place to go; they would go there and wait, rather than compete with somebody else in another cove Fred Hope But over the years all of the spots on my South Side like Dorothy Narrows, Three Entrace Bay, Pirates Cove Samsing Cove, Samsing, Sandy Cove, Jamestown Bay, we haven't got anything out of there in years. Wade Martin Jamestown bay, Camp Coogan, it would take too long to name every little bit James Nielsen The channel used to be full of herring, Jamestown bay used to be full of herring Walter Mov The whole bay used to be covered with spawn James Nielsen All the way into town Jessie Johnnie Spawn through the channels, spawn in totem park, spawn in Jamestown bay Fred Hope And then they would quit there for a little while, and then continue into Old Sitka and near Halak Island Jessie Johnnie From Middle Island out to Vitskari Rocks and out to Cape Edgecumbe used to be full of herring; Shelikof Bay used to be full of herring Walter Moy I don't see this any more Jessie Johnnie We don't see this anymore iames Nielsen Not anymore. Walter Moy But there was nothing there... it was a false spawn ted Borbridge But when I went back, my branches were bare... Mim Bartels Last year we went to Middle Island; that was the only place to fill our needs. But it was still not enough. James Nielsen What is being managed today is just a remnant stock of what could be, and what should be, in order for the wildlife, for the subsistence users, and for everyone fishing to be successful at those things Robi Craig The herring not only support the sac roe fishery, but a much larger organic web as far as the fish and the marine mammals and the birds are concerned Jack Lorrigan We need to protect our customary subsistence use of the herring stock and
