### 2016 UPPER YENTNA FISH WHEEL SUBSISTENCE SALMON FISHERY REGULATIONS

Following is a summary of the 2016 Upper Yentna Fish Wheel Subsistence Salmon Fishery regulations. This summary is not quoted verbatim from codified regulations. It is an informative abstract simplified for your convenience. If clarification is needed, contact the Department of Fish and Game Office in Palmer (746-6300) or the Fish and Wildlife Protection Division of the Department of Public Safety (761-7136).

1. Permits must be returned to the Department of Fish and Game by August 15, 2016. The permit must be returned whether or not you fished or caught any fish. **A permittee who fails to comply with the reporting requirements is ineligible to receive a subsistence permit for that activity during the following calendar year, unless the permit applicant demonstrates to the department that failure to report was due to unavoidable circumstances.**
2. The seasonal limit is 25 salmon for the permit holder and 10 salmon for each additional household member. The seasonal limit is determined when the permit is issued.
3. The fishery occurs in the main-stem Yentna River from its confluence with Martin Creek upstream to its confluence with the Skwentna River.
4. Fish may only be taken from 4:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, from July 15 through August 7.
5. Each fish wheel must have a live box. The live box must be constructed so that it contains no less than 45 cubic feet of water volume while it is in operation.
6. All king salmon and rainbow trout must be released.
7. The permit holder shall attach a wood or metal plate that is at least 12 inches high by 12 inches wide, bearing the permit holder's name and address in letters and numerals at least one inch high to each fish wheel operated under this section so that the name and address are plainly visible.
8. The permit holder must be present to attend the wheel when it is fishing.
9. Fish must be recorded in ink on the permit immediately upon harvesting.
10. Participants must report their daily harvest of salmon to the Palmer Fish and Game office at 746-6332 (leave message if after business hours) by noon of the day following an open period.
