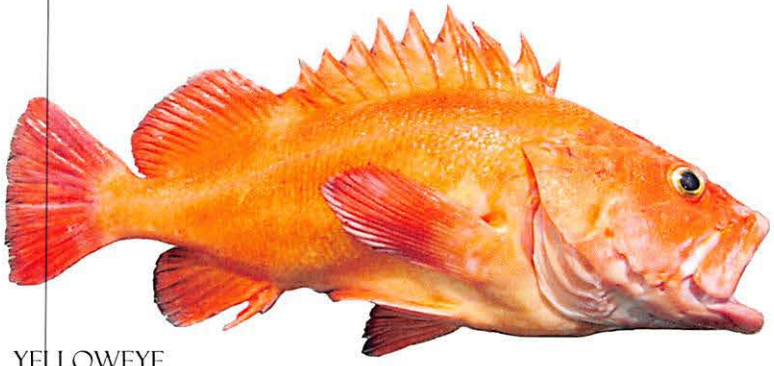

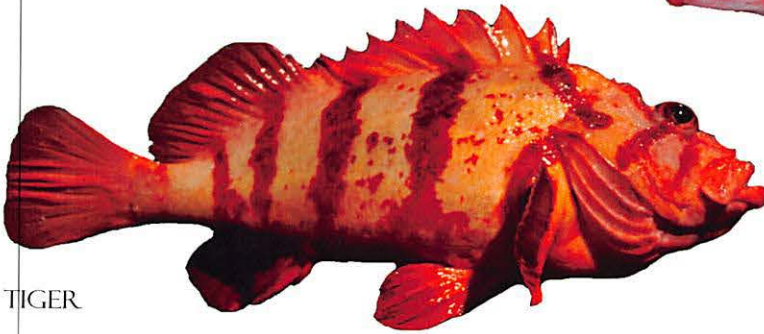

All anglers fishing in salt waters of Southeast Alaska will be required to utilize a deepwater release device to return all rockfish that are not harvested to the depth of capture, or to at least 100 feet, whichever is shallower.



COMMON NONPELAGIC SLOPE AND PELAGIC ROCKFISH - RETENTION IS ALLOWED

Other nonpelagic slope rockfish not pictured include: blackgill, blackspotted, bocaccio, brown, chilipepper, darkblotched, greenstriped, harlequin, northern, Pacific ocean perch, Puget Sound, pygmy, redstripe, sharpchin, shortbelly, splitnose, stripetail, yellowmouth, and blue (pelagic)

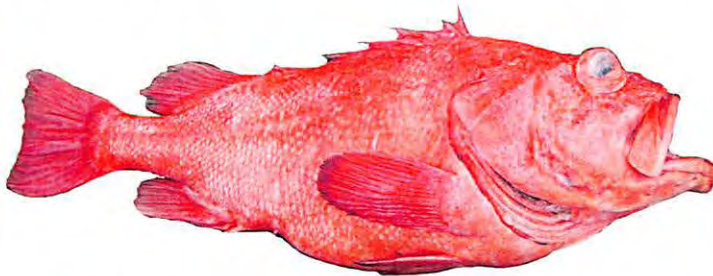

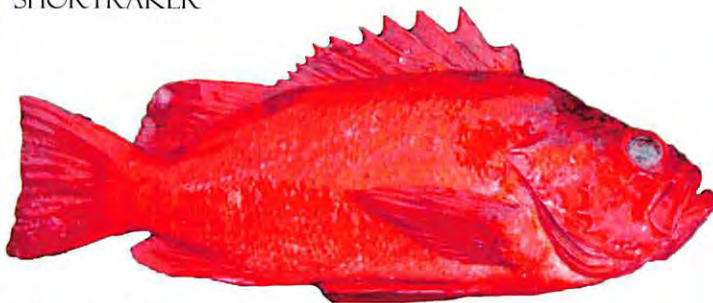
