The Troll King Fishery Losses in the Past 25 Years

- 1994-1996 change in troll/sport allocation at the board of fish from 83/17 to 80/20 over 3 years.
- 1998 35% reduction due to Pacific Salmon Treaty, and closure of areas of high abundance
- 2008 15% reduction due to Pacific Salmon Treaty
- 2018 13.2% is loss of harvest according to McDowell Group or 7.5% loss of allocation according to State of Alaska
- 2018 loss of fishing area due to Stocks of Concern. This includes a loss of 6 weeks of winter trolling, reduced spring openings that were to target hatchery kings
