5 AAC 67.022 is amended to read:

- (1) In the Togiak River Drainage the following special provisions apply:
- (1) only unbaited, single-hook artificial lures or flies may be used; except that bait and a single hook may be used from July 16 to April 30;
- (2) the bag and possession limit for king salmon less than 20 inches in length is 10 fish;
- (3) any king salmon caught that are 20 inches or greater in length must be immediately released; and
- (4) upstream of the confluence of Gechiak Creek and the Togiak River, sport fishing for king salmon is closed year round.
