# Fairbanks Fish and Game Advisory Committee (FAC) February 14, 2024 JP Jones Center, Fairbanks, Alaska Comments on Upper Cook Inlet Proposals, Alaska Board of Fisheries 2024

This record of decisions on Upper Cook Inlet Board of Fisheries proposals is being submitted by the Fairbanks Fish and Game Advisory Committee (FAC) pending completion of minutes of February 14, 2024, to be submitted shortly.

This meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Mark Richards, Acting Chair. There was a quorum and the FAC passed two motions relevant to these proposals:

- (1) To give full FAC support to the deliberations of the FAC Fisheries SubCommittee on the proposals
