Substitute language for proposal 232:

5 AAC Chapter 56 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 AAC 56.XXX. Methods and Means Multiple Lines. Except as provided in 5 AAC 75.021, an Alaska resident sport fishing for species with a bag limit of greater than one fish is allowed to fish with 2 closely attended lines, provided only one hook or artificial lure is used on each line.

5 AAC Chapter 57 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 AAC 57.XXX. Methods and Means Multiple Lines. Except as provided in 5 AAC 75.021, an Alaska resident sport fishing for species with a bag limit of greater than one fish is allowed to fish with 2 closely attended lines, provided only one hook or artificial lure is used on each line.

5 AAC Chapter 58 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 AAC 58.XXX. Methods and Means Multiple Lines. Except as provided in 5 AAC 75.021, an Alaska resident sport fishing for species with a bag limit of greater than one fish is allowed to fish with 2 closely attended lines, provided only one hook or artificial lure is used on each line.

5 AAC Chapter 59 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 AAC 59.XXX. Methods and Means Multiple Lines. Except as provided in 5 AAC 75.021, an Alaska resident sport fishing for species with a bag limit of greater than one fish is allowed to fish with 2 closely attended lines, provided only one hook or artificial lure is used on each line.

5 AAC Chapter 60 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 AAC 60.XXX. Methods and Means Multiple Lines. Except as provided in 5 AAC 75.021, an Alaska resident sport fishing for species with a bag limit of greater than one fish is allowed to fish with 2 closely attended lines, provided only one hook or artificial lure is used on each line.

5 AAC Chapter 61 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 AAC 61.XXX. Methods and Means Multiple Lines. Except as provided in 5 AAC 75.021, an Alaska resident sport fishing for species with a bag limit of greater than one fish is allowed to fish with 2 closely attended lines, provided only one hook or artificial lure is used on each line.

5 AAC Chapter 62 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 AAC 62.XXX. Methods and Means Multiple Lines. Except as provided in 5 AAC 75.021, an Alaska resident sport fishing for species with a bag limit of greater than one fish is allowed to fish with 2 closely attended lines, provided only one hook or artificial lure is used on each line.
