## Delegation of Authority

In accordance with AS 16.05.270, the Alaska Board of Fisheries delegates to the Commissioner of Fish and Game the authority to adopt and make permanent changes to 5 AAC 58, 5 AAC 55 and 5 AAC 28. This delegation is restricted to decreasing the size limit for lingcod from 35 inches to 32 inches based on the new information presented by the department at the January 1993 meeting in Kodiak. The intent of this delegation is not to eliminate or increase the size limit for lingcod.

Lingcod proposals are not scheduled for consideration at any of the remaining meetings during the spring 1993 board cycle. The board finds it necessary to address conservation concerns for lingcod before the fall 1993 board cycle begins and, therefore, delegates authority to the Commissioner to amend the referenced chapters to reduce the size limit limitations on lingcod.

The board would like to have the delegated regulations in effect by July 1, 1993. Therefore, the board requests the department to expedite review of the regulations.
