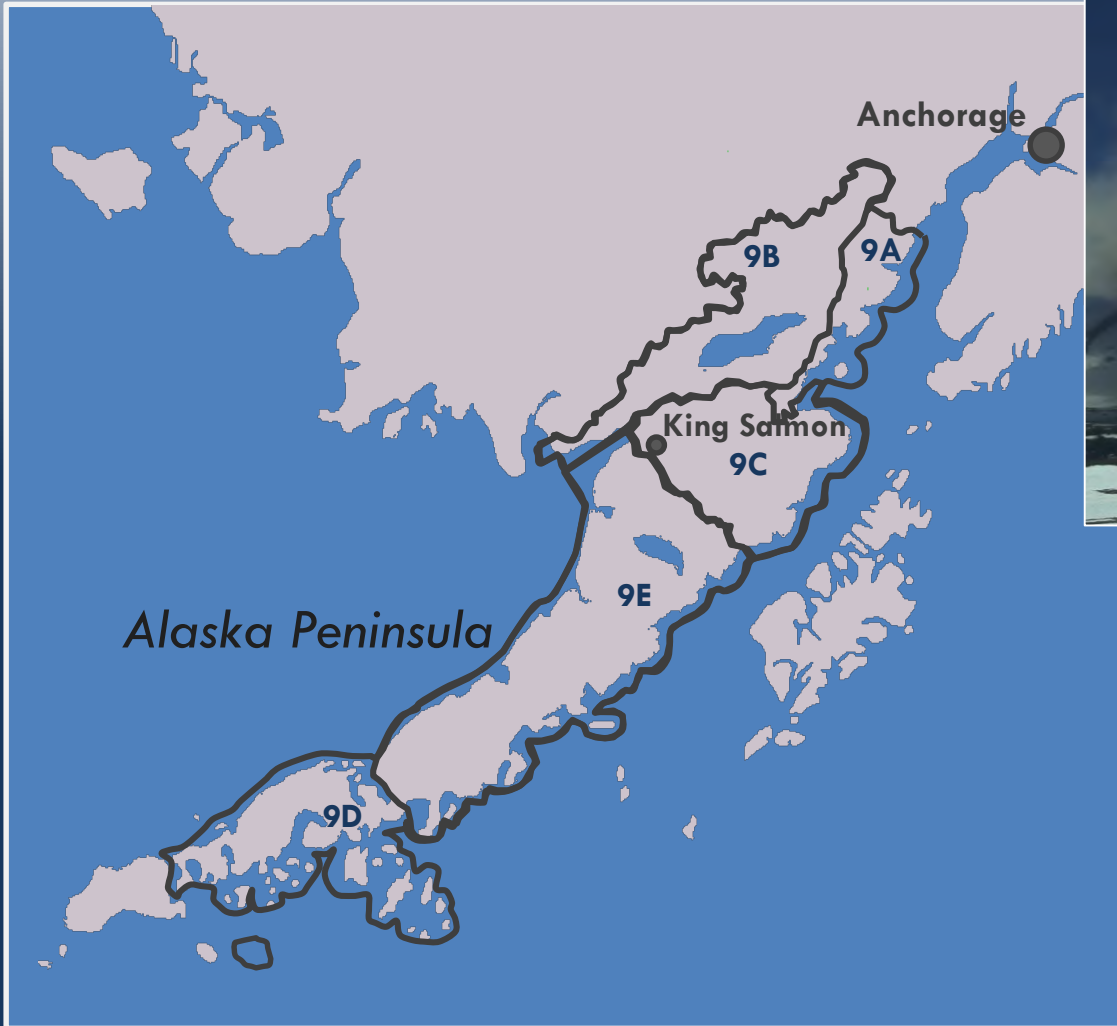

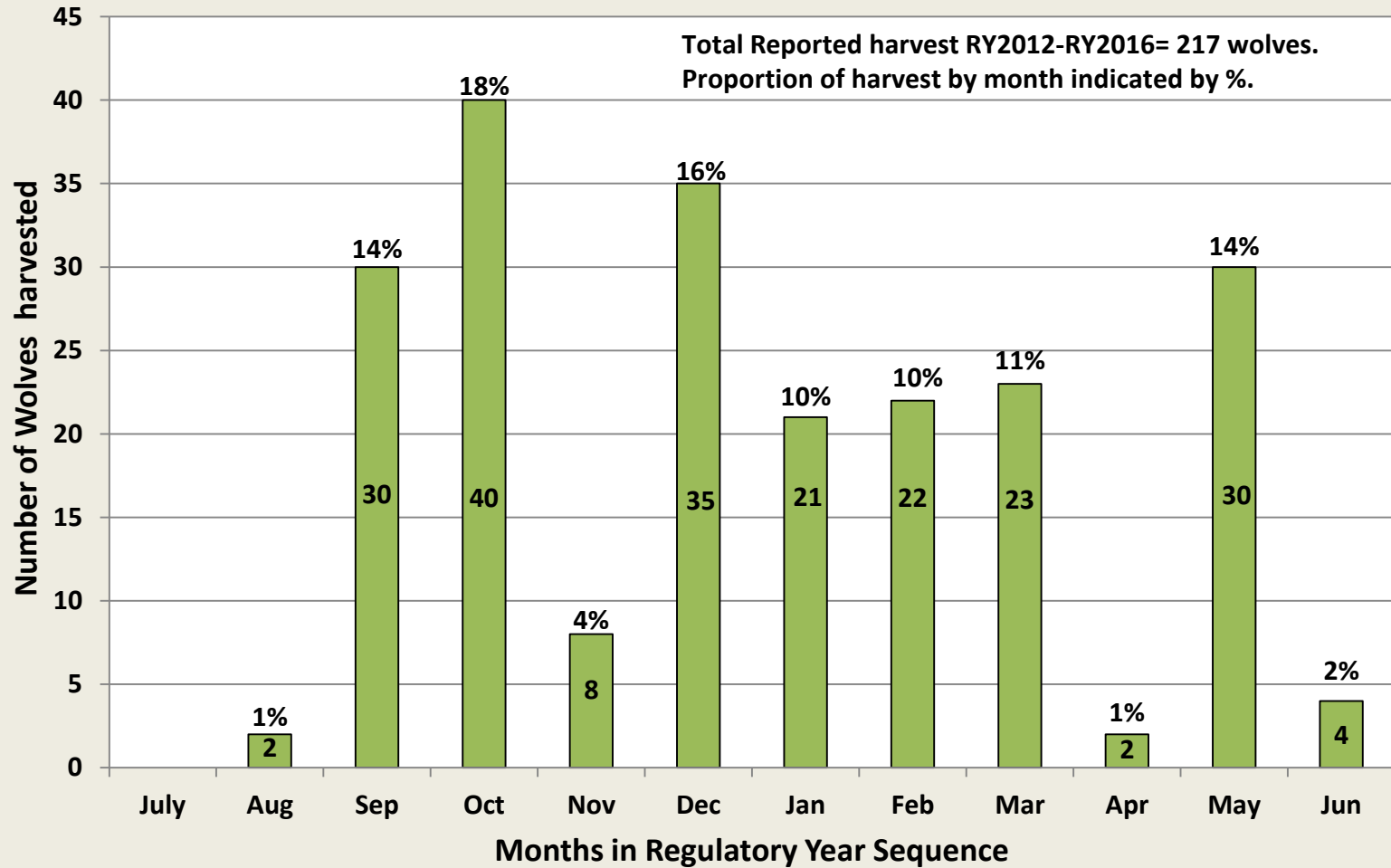

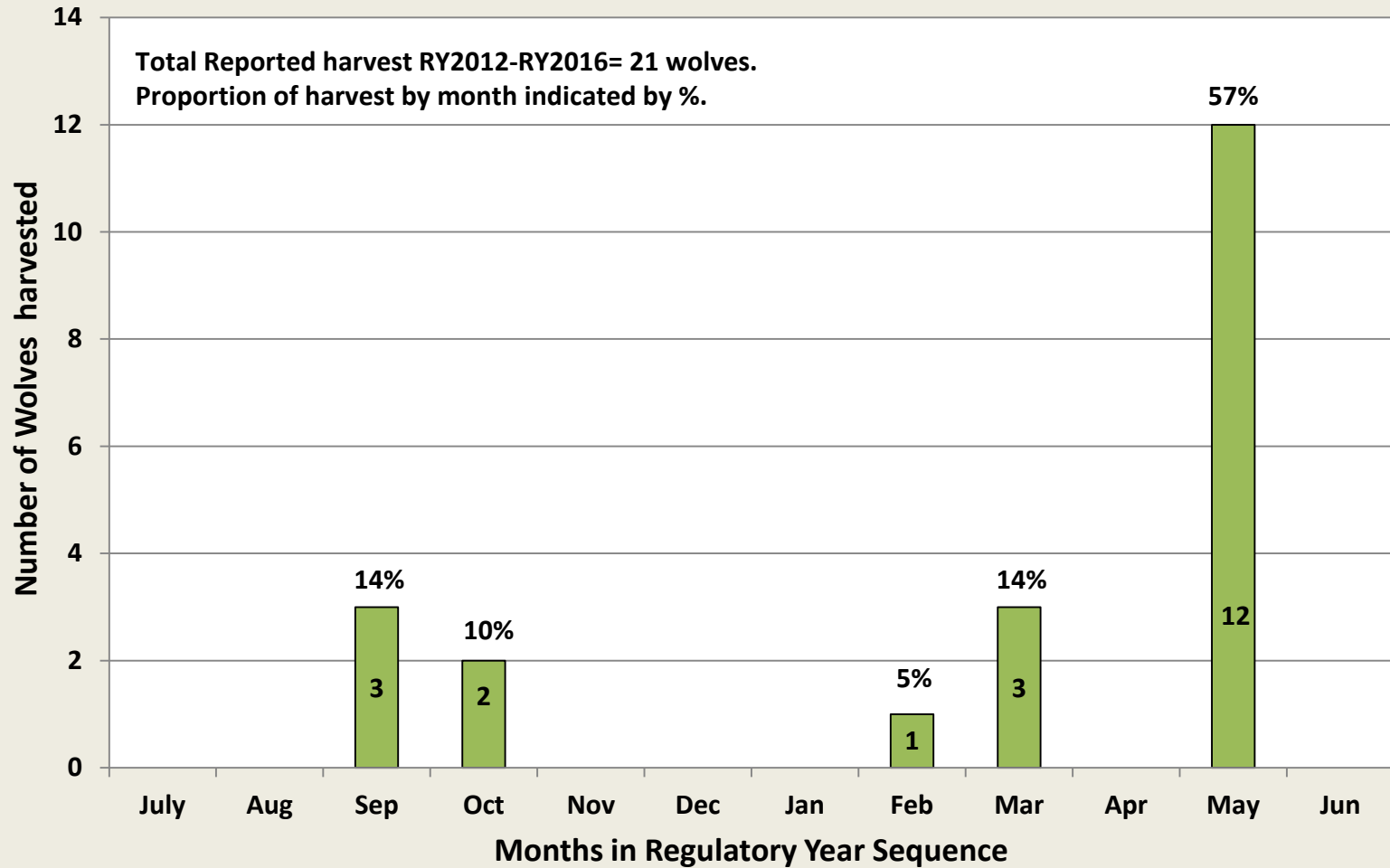
## Unit 9 Cumulative Reported Wolf Harvest Distribution by Month, Regulatory Years 2012-2016

Hunting: August 10 – June 30

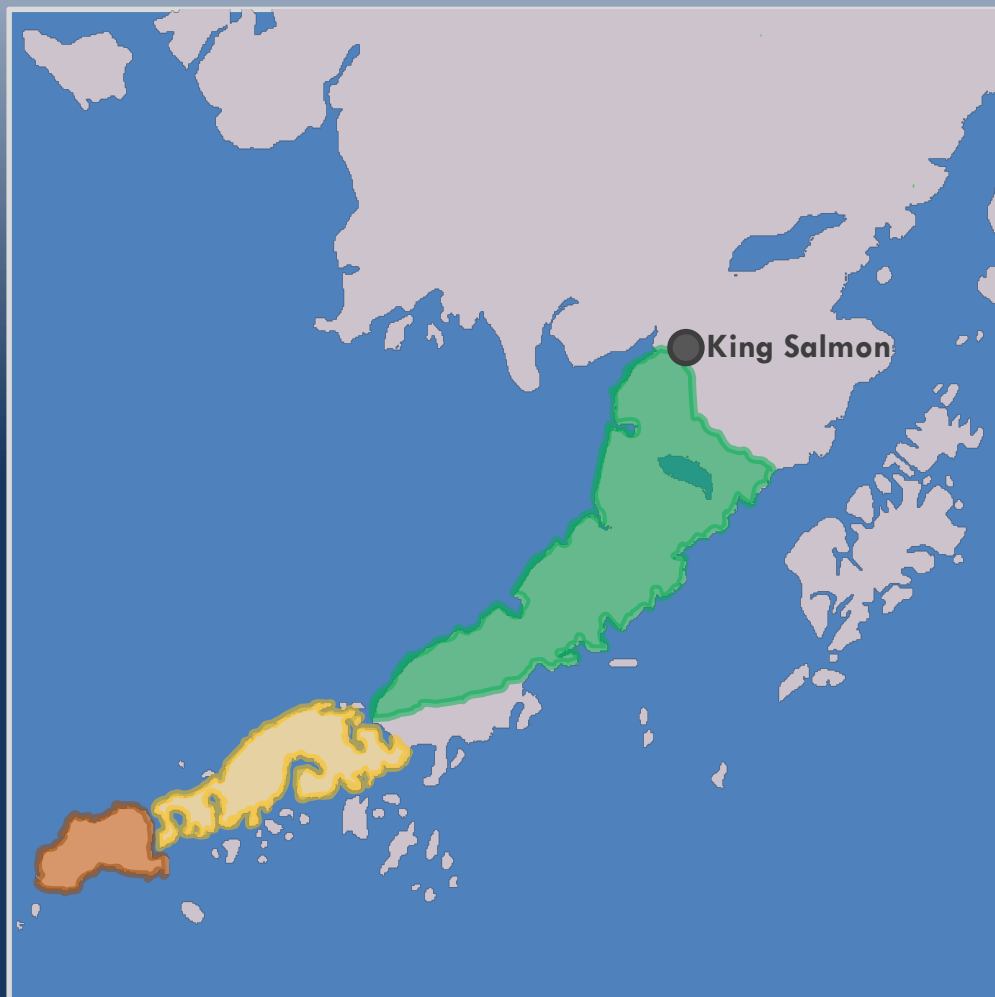

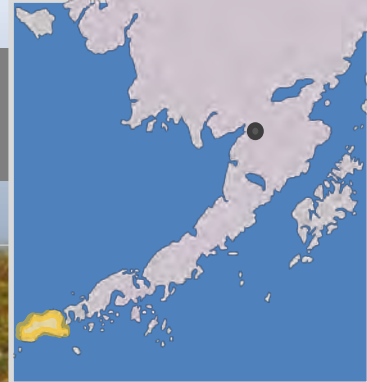

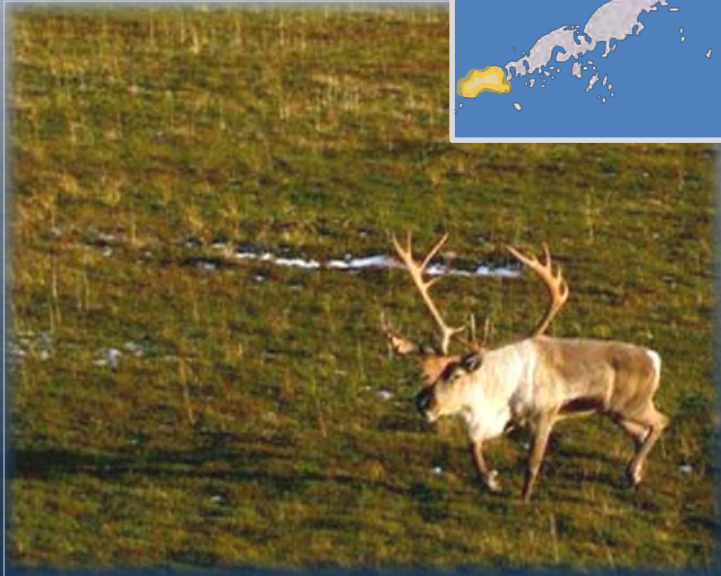

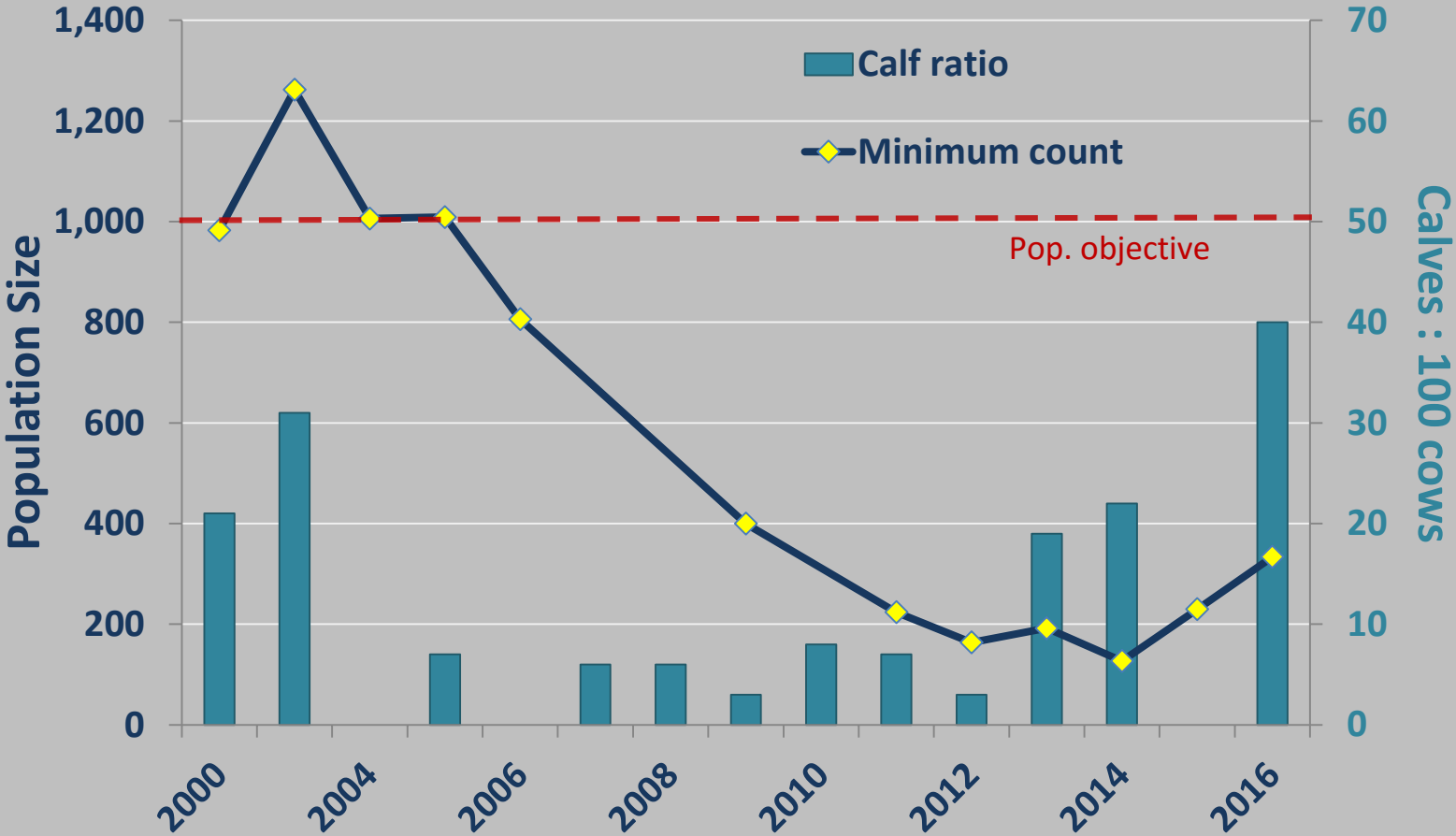

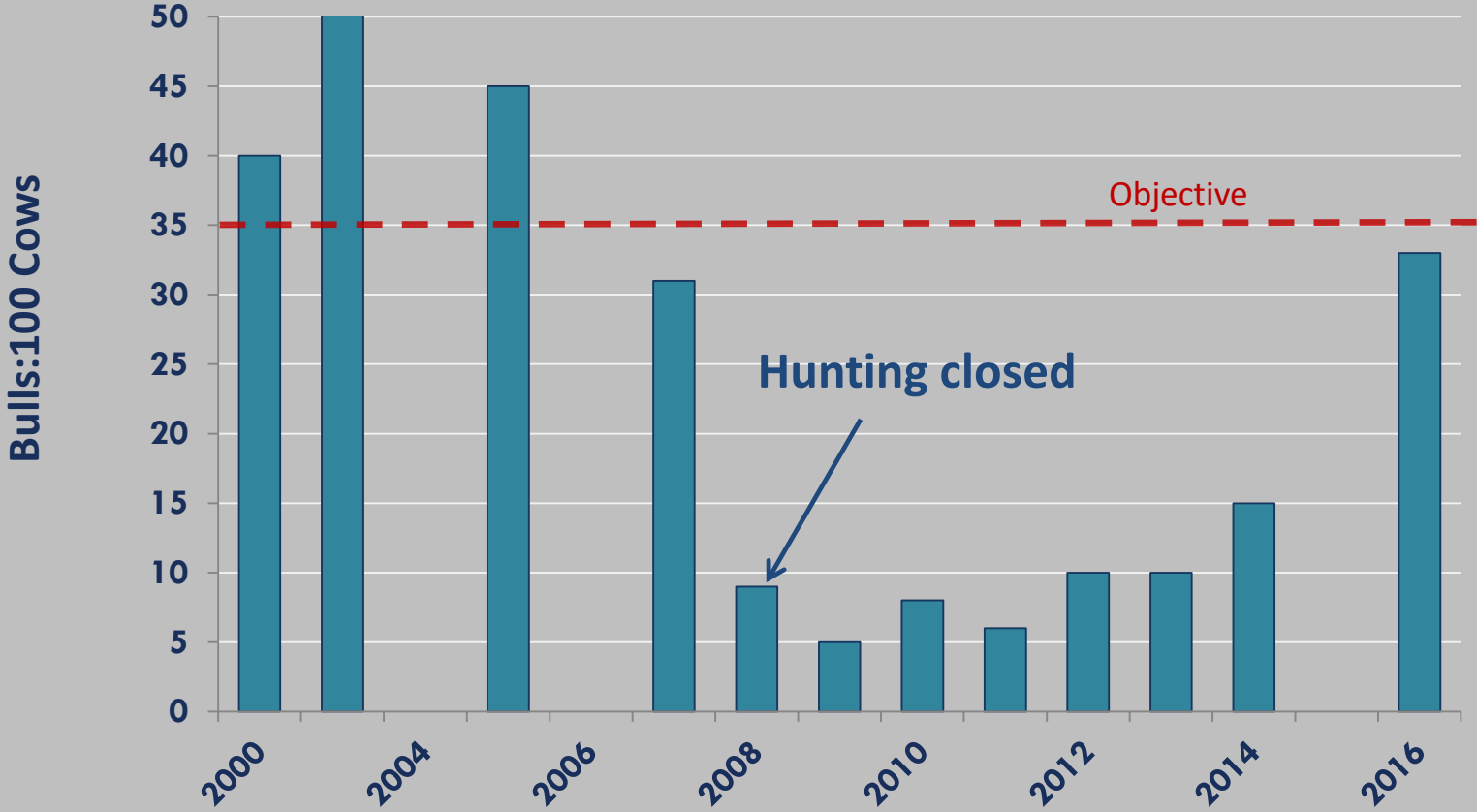
### Population Size and Fall Calf Ratio (UCH)
