#### **Customary and Traditional Use Criteria**

Criterion 1: Length and consistency of use

Criterion 2: Seasonality

Criterion 3: Methods and means of harvest

Criterion 4: Geographic areas

Criterion 5: Means of handling, preparing, preserving, and storing

Criterion 6: Intergenerational transmission of knowledge, skills, values, and lore

Criterion 7: Distribution and exchange

Criterion 8: Diversity of resources in an area; economic, cultural, social, and nutritional

### **Amounts Reasonably Necessary for Subsistence (ANS)**

**Subsistence statute** requires the Board to determine the amount of the harvestable portion of a fish stock that is reasonably necessary for subsistence uses [AS 16.05.258(b)]

#### ANS is not:

- Indicator of subsistence "need"
- · Quota or harvest cap
- · Inseason management tool
- Made for specific communities

#### ANS is:

- Guideline for the Board to evaluate if reasonable opportunity for subsistence uses is being provided under existing regulations
- Tool for the Board to allocate between subsistence and nonsubsistence uses
- Range of numbers: historical harvest and numbers of Alaskans
- Department is neutral
- Public input

### **Subsistence and Nonsubsistence Areas**



- Subsistence regulations do not apply within nonsubsistence areas.
- C&T and ANS apply to subsistence harvests outside nonsubsistence areas.


