My quick notes to be included for the data included would be:

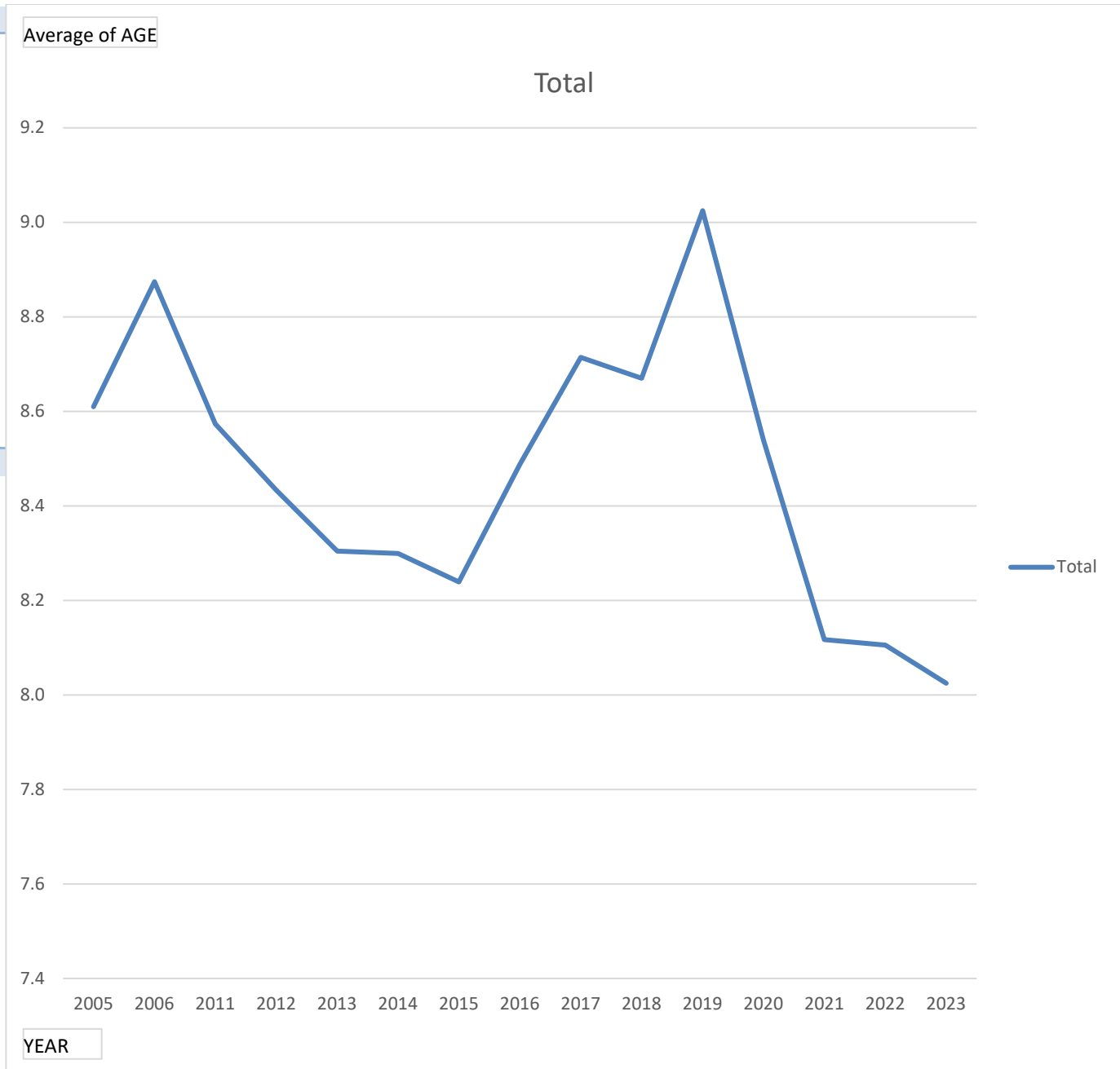
- There was not data provided from 2003-2004 as those records had not been digitally archived by the department.
- I am unsure why, but years 2007-2010 were not included.
- All data on the tables is averaged. This is due to the fact that this data set included over 34,410 data points. Data removed from original data set was < 2%.
- The following abbreviations are:
  - o RHL = Right Horn Length
  - o RHB = Right Horn Base Circumference
  - o LHL = Left Horn Length
  - o AVG = Average

As stated in my testimony, this shows a very consistent tie to the average ram is 8yrs old, has 34.5” horns and bases with a circumference of 12.9”. My primary position would stay the same in that we need to focus on putting more old/trophy rams on the mountain to ensure our sheep herds have biological stability.

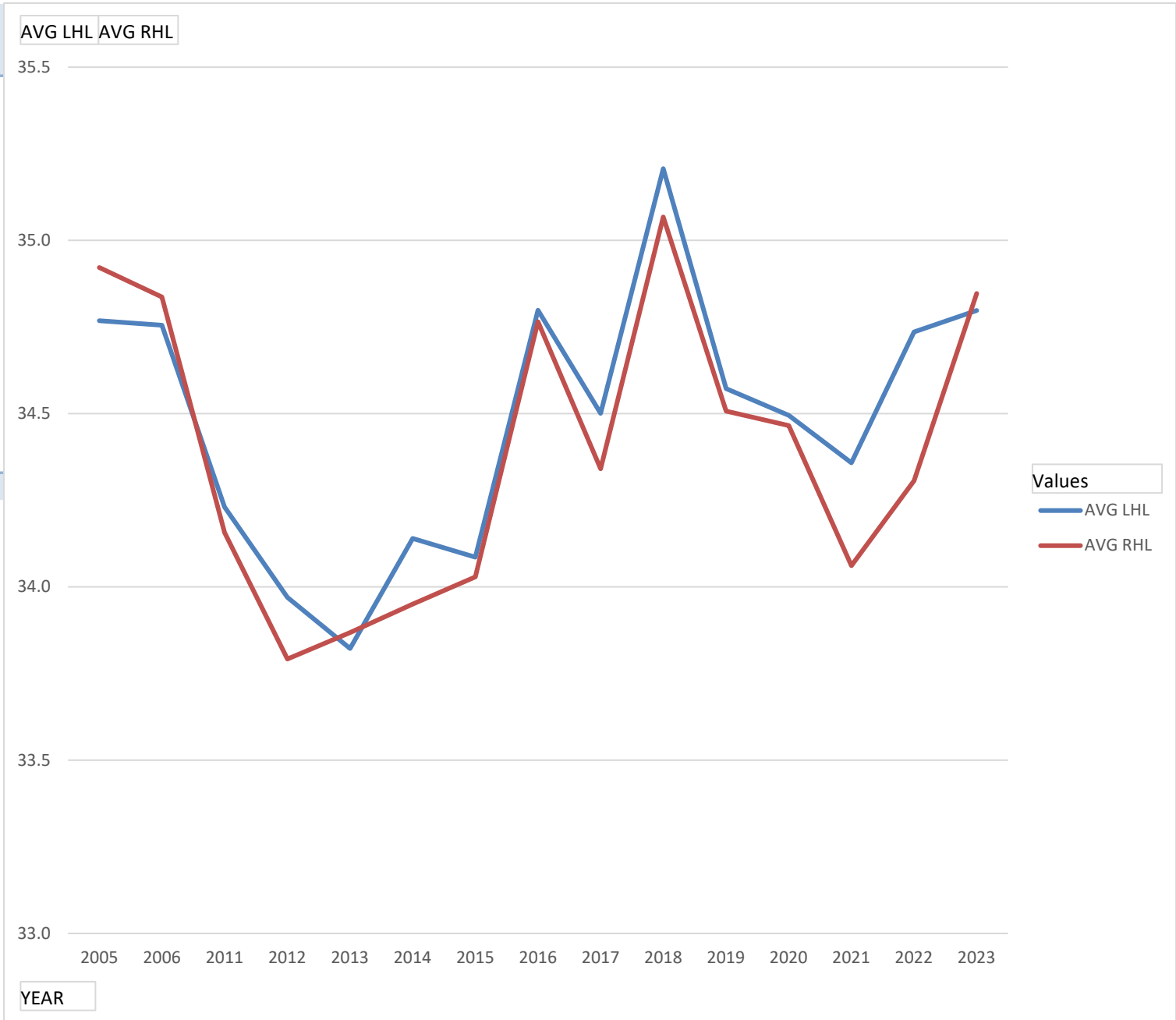
