

Submitted by Dan Montgomery Proposal 131 Delta Non-resident Sheep Draw  
Permits

The intent of this proposal is clarify what was put in place by the Board at the statewide meeting in March of 2022 when they approved proposal 149, guaranteeing 10% of the total number of sheep permits to non-residents and not the “ UP TO 10%” language that was in place before.

Currently there are 84 permits being issued and 8 of them are for non-residents.

There are 7 Non-resident Guided Only Permits issued under DS 205 and one issued under Guided By Resident Relatives Only under DS003. I’m asking that the Non-resident Guided Permits Only be issued in both hunt periods split evenly as possible between both hunts. Currently they are being issued all in either the early hunt period Aug. 10 to Aug. 25 or the late hunt period Aug. 26 to Sept. 20.

I suggest using these numbers for those hunts DS 003 for the 2nd degree permit. That is the number that is being used now

DS 303 for the Aug. 10th to Aug. 25<sup>th</sup> Guided Non- resident hunt, 3 permits.

DS 304 for the Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> to Sept. 20<sup>th</sup> Guided Non-resident hunt, 4 permits.

They would appear as below:

20D, 13B, and 20A,

Delta Controlled Use Area

Nonresidents Guided Only DS 303 - Aug. 10<sup>th</sup> to Aug. 25<sup>th</sup> - 3 permits

Non-residents Guided Only DS 304 – Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> to Aug. 25<sup>th</sup> - 4 permits

Non-residents Guided By DS 003 - Aug. 10<sup>th</sup> to Aug. 25<sup>th</sup> or  
Resident Relatives Only Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> to Sept. 20<sup>th</sup> 1 permit
