Caribou / Unit 18

This proposal seeks to close hunting by creating a moratorium on the Mulchatna Caribou herd (MCH) for five to ten years with a review every five years.

- The Board identified MCH as important for providing high levels of harvest for human consumption
- Intensive Management (IM) objective of 30,000 to 80,000
- IM harvest objective of 2,400-8,000
- Positive customary and traditional use finding for Units 9A, 9B, 17, 18, 19A and 19B
- ANS for MCH is 2,100-2,400.

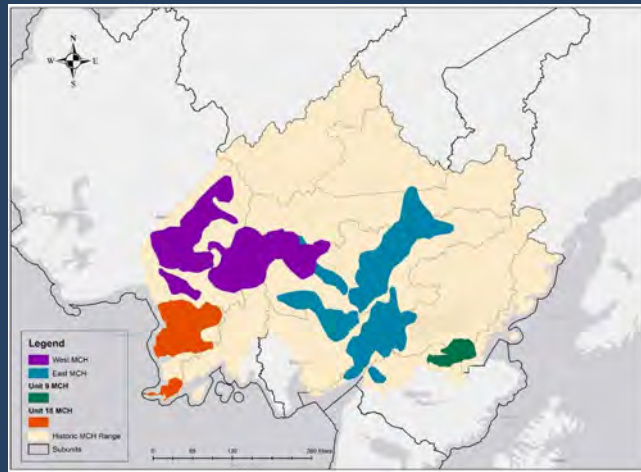

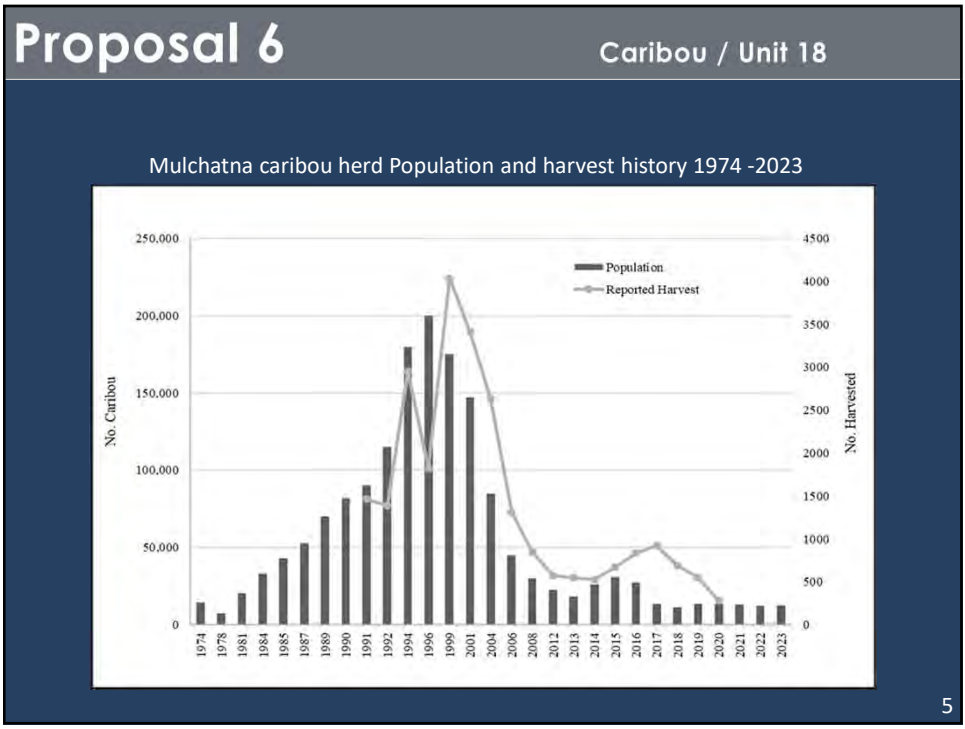
Historic range of MCH in Units 9, 17, 18 and 19

- Browse removal rates are high and twinning rates are declining.
- Bull: Cow ratios are similar to un-hunted moose populations.
- Additional harvest can be used to reduce the overall moose abundance, which would improve nutritional indices.
- However, we do not expect a significant increase in harvest as a result of this proposal.
