Fairbanks AC List:

- 1) eliminate rural meetings;
- 2) limit out of area department travel to meetings;
- 4) reduction of bulk of regulations;
- 5) more Spartan meeting sites;
- 6) video conference for department staff who are giving limited presentations;
- 7) trim or eliminate the regional overviews;
- 8) allowing telephonic AC testimony (may reduce AC influence);
- 9) restricting DPS and Department comments to the time for public testimony;
- 10) eliminate antlerless moose and brown bear tag fee annual re-authorization;
- 11) would cutting the number of ACs result in any savings;
- 12) eliminating use of sub-committees and working groups;
- 13) longer hours for each day of the meeting;
- 14) legislative change to the open meetings act to allow email polling; 15)
