Deadline Approaches for Joint Board Proposals Concerning Fish and Game Advisory Committees, Processes for Adopting Regulations, and Subsistence Uses

The Joint Board of Fisheries and Game reminds Alaskans that the May 1 deadline is fast approaching for submitting proposed regulation changes pertaining to local fish and game advisory committees, the processes for adopting regulations by the Board of Fisheries and the Board of Game, and subsistence uses. Regulations open on the call for proposal submission are 5 AAC Chapters 96, 97 and 99 which includes the following topics:

- Establishment and distribution of local fish and game advisory committees
- Advisory committee membership make-up and qualifications
- Uniform rules of operation for advisory committee meetings
- Advisory committee areas of jurisdiction for emergency closures
- Procedures for developing fish and game regulations
- Emergency petition and subsistence proposal policies
- Boards of Fisheries and Game subsistence procedures.
- Joint Board nonsubsistence areas*.

Proposals received by the May 1 deadline will be considered by the joint board at its meeting scheduled for March 25–29, 2024 in Anchorage. *Proposals related to nonsubsistence areas must address information related to at least one of the 12 socioeconomic characteristics as specified on the Call for Proposals.
