Findings: We surveyed this cataloged stream using baited minnow traps and GPS. We captured juvenile coho salmon, Dolly Varden, and cutthroat trout. The stream flows through a channel dominated by fines and a 5-foot culvert poorly aligned to the creek (Table 1; Figures 1, 2).

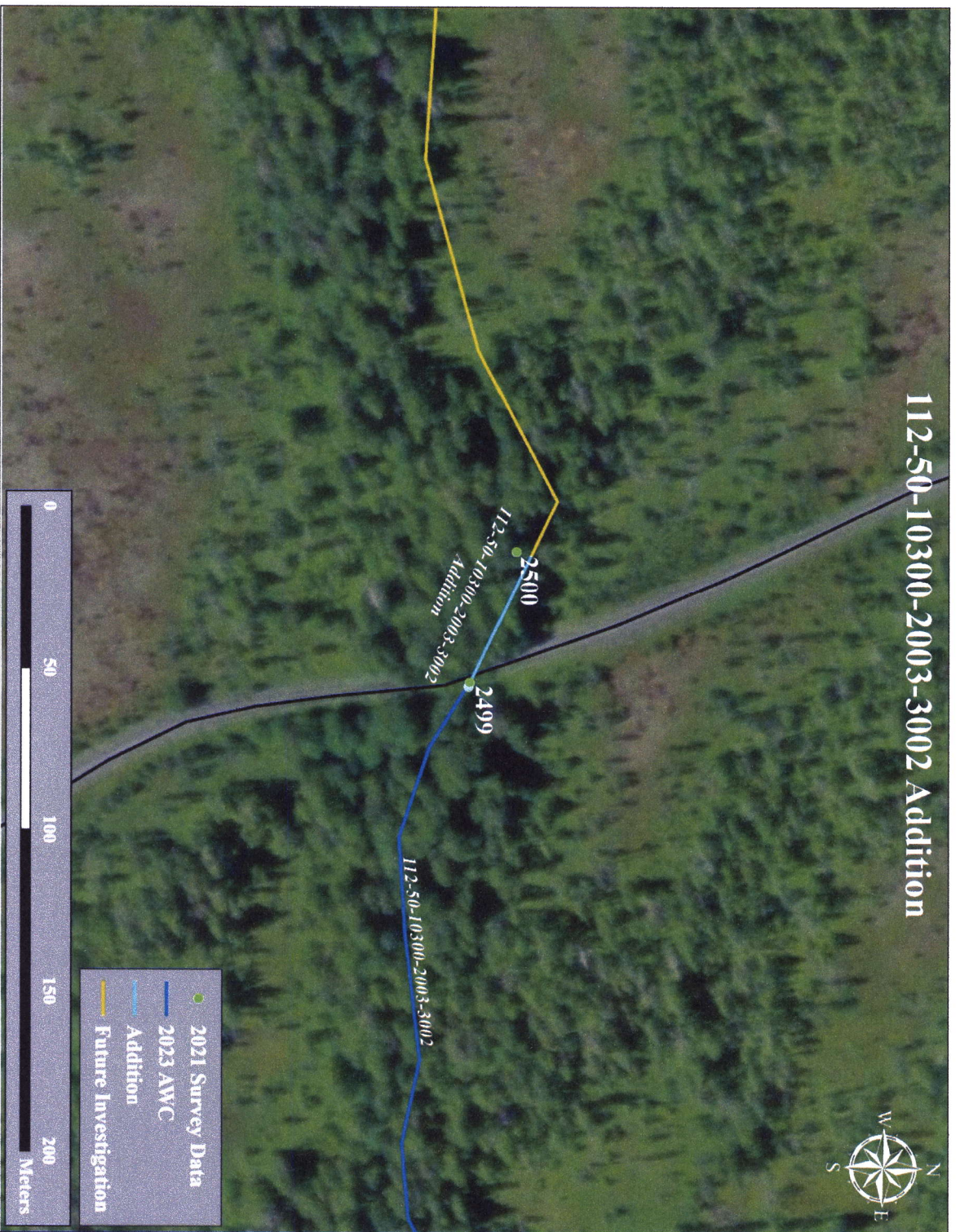


Figure 3.—Stream No. 112-50-10300-2003-3002 addition map.

Recommendations: Extend upper extent of Stream No. 112-50-10300-2003-3002 in the anadromous waters catalog (Figure 3).
