Findings: We surveyed this uncataloged stream using baited minnow traps and a GPS and captured juvenile coho salmon and cutthroat trout (Figure 1). The stream channel runs through a muskeg and into a ditch, channel continues upstream into the forest (Table 1; Figures 2, 3).

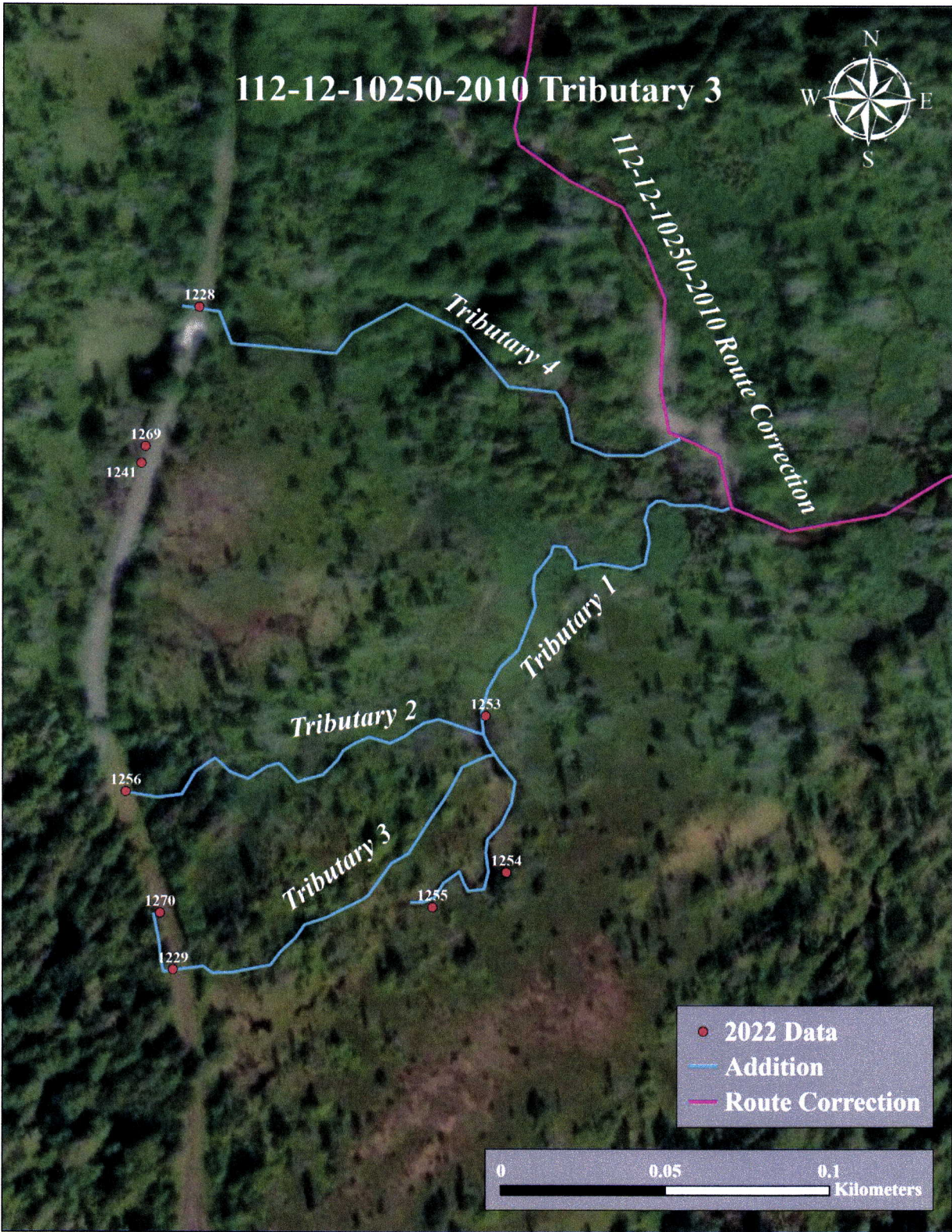


Figure 4.—112-12-10250-2010 tributary 3 addition map.

Recommendations: Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing coho salmon (Figure 4).
