Findings: We surveyed this cataloged stream using a backpack electrofisher and GPS and captured juvenile coho salmon and cutthroat trout. The stream parallels the road and consists of a mixture of boulders, cobble, and large gravel. The stream survey ended at waypoint 625 due to time limitations, but fish habitat likely continues upstream (Table 1; Figures 1–3).

Recommendations: Extend upper extent of Stream No. 113-59-10040-2416 in the anadromous waters catalog up to waypoint 625 and route correct the stream near the confluence of tributary 3 (Figures 4, 5). [**Please see Nom #24-762 for route correction at confluence of Tributary #3](#)

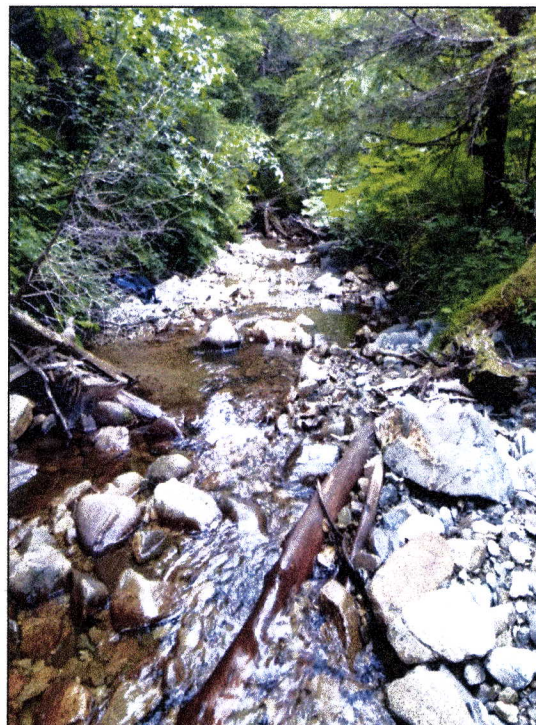


Figure 2. Downstream at waypoint 625.

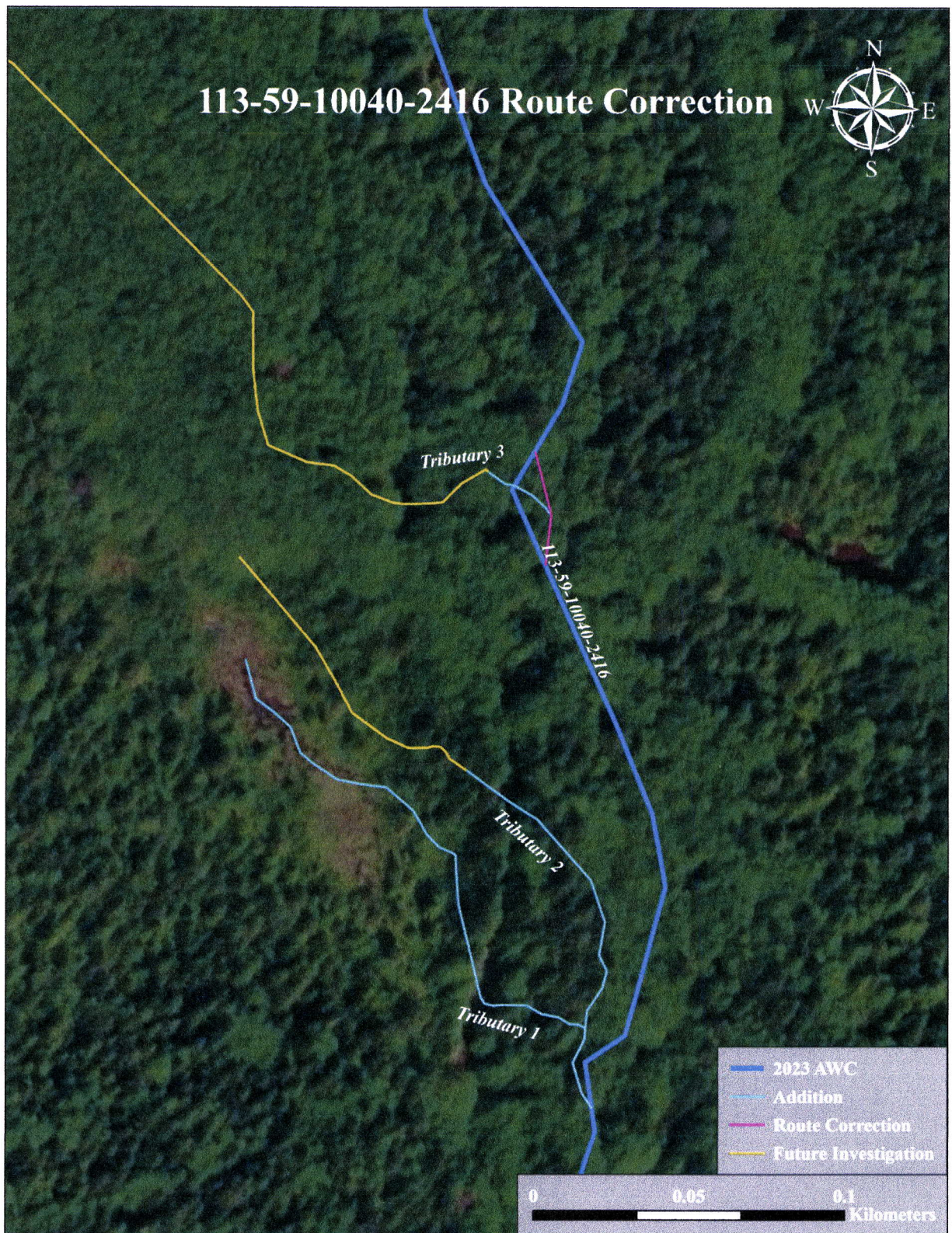
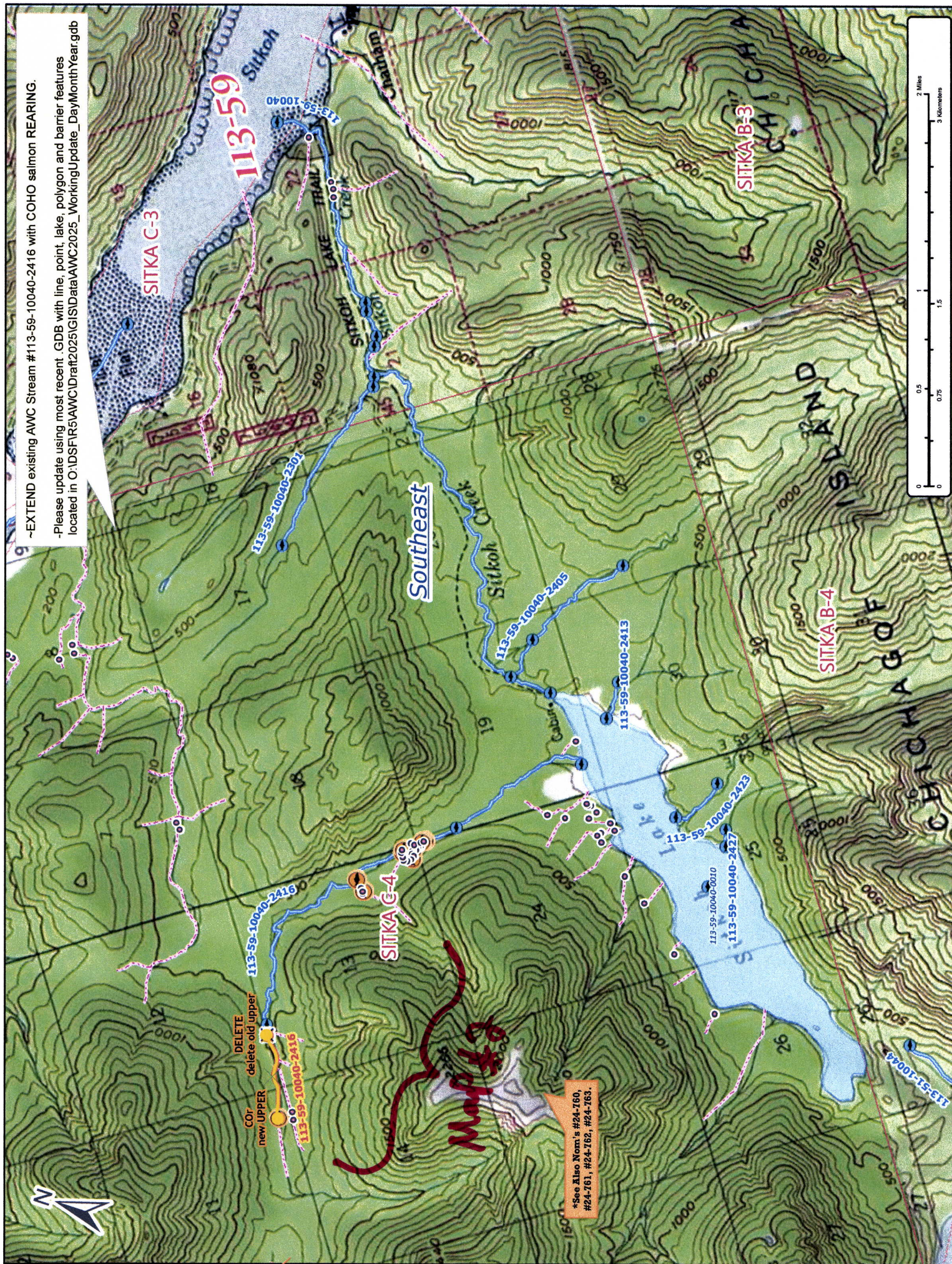


Figure 5. Stream No. 113-59-10040-2416 route correction map.

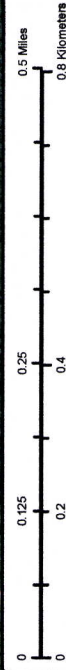
