


Figure 1.–Downstream view of tributary 1 at waypoint 1079.

**Findings:** We surveyed this uncataloged stream using baited minnow traps and GPS. We captured juvenile coho salmon and sculpin. The stream flows through tidally-influenced wetlands near the mouth of the Mendenhall River (Table 1; Figures 1–3).




Figure 4.—111-50-10490 tributary 1 addition map.

**Recommendations:** Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing coho salmon (Figure 4).
