## East Port Frederick Uncataloged Stream

**Findings:** We surveyed this uncataloged stream using a backpack electrofisher and GPS. We captured juvenile coho salmon, cutthroat trout, and sculpin. The stream descends a 6-8% gradient and flows through a gravel channel into the intertidal (Table 1; Figures 1, 2).




Figure 3.—Uncataloged stream addition map.

**Recommendations:** Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing coho salmon (Figure 3).
