Findings: We surveyed the road crossing of this cataloged stream using a backpack electrofisher and GPS. We captured juvenile coho salmon and found that the stream path is incorrectly mapped (Figure 1). We recommend correcting the route of the stream to reflect the route identified by the field survey and updated imagery (Table 1; Figures 2, 3).




Figure 4.–112-12-10250-2010 route correction map.

Recommendations: Correct Stream No. 112-12-10250-2010 in the anadromous waters catalog to reflect the field verified stream path and add rearing coho salmon to the species and lifestage present (Figure 4).
