**Findings:** We surveyed this uncataloged stream using a backpack electrofisher and GPS. We captured juvenile coho salmon, Dolly Varden, and cutthroat trout. The tributary stream descends a steep hillside, decreases in gradient, and flows through a gravel channel with moderate woody debris (Table 1; Figures 1, 2).

**Recommendations:** Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing coho salmon (Figure 3).
